A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE FOR ANNUAL REGULAR SIXTY-DAY SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"[A.] Each regular session of the legislature shall begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January [Every regular session of the legislature convening during an odd-numbered year] and shall remain in session not to exceed sixty days [and every regular session of the legislature convening during an even-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed thirty days]. No special session of the legislature shall exceed thirty days.
