AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND A PILOT STUDY TO PROVIDE STRESS REDUCTION AND STRESS MANAGEMENT TRAINING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT FIRST RESPONDERS THROUGHOUT NEW MEXICO; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$315,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in fiscal years 2008 and 2009 to fund a pilot program for stress reduction and stress management training for law enforcement officers, firefighters, emergency medical personnel, tribal police and other first responders throughout the state, using Santa Febased clinical staff with expertise in treating acute and post-traumatic stress disorders to educate personnel in at least seven multiple staff departments and establishing a continuing

education credit credential for such training. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2009 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
