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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. NATURAL GAS EMERGENCY INVESTIGATION TASK
17	FORCEPOWERS AND DUTIESAGENCY COOPERATION
18	A. The "natural gas emergency investigation task
19	force" is created and shall be composed of the following
20	members:
21	(1) the secretary of finance and
22	administration or the secretary's designee;
23	(2) the secretary of homeland security and
24	emergency management or the secretary's designee;
25	(3) the chair of the public regulation

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1	commission or another commissioner designated by the chair;
2	(4) the adjutant general or the adjutant
3	general's designee;
4	(5) the attorney general or the attorney
5	general's designee;
6	(6) the superintendent of insurance or the
7	superintendent's designee;
8	(7) one majority party member and one minority
9	party member of the house of representatives to be appointed by
10	the speaker of the house of representatives; and
11	(8) one majority party member and one minority
12	party member of the senate to be appointed by the president pro
13	tempore of the senate.
14	B. The secretary of finance and administration
15	shall serve as chair of the task force.
16	C. The task force shall:
17	(1) investigate how and why New Mexico
18	consumers lost natural gas service in early February 2011;
19	(2) investigate the economic and social
20	impacts of the loss;
21	(3) investigate the adequacy of the state's
22	and local governments' response to the emergency;
23	(4) determine how to safeguard deliverability
24	and operational efficiency in the natural gas pipeline system
25	to prevent undue hardship on New Mexico natural gas consumers;
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1 invite representatives of federal agencies (5) 2 that regulate interstate pipelines and transportation of 3 natural gas to assist in the task force's duties; 4 (6) invite a representative of the federal emergency management agency to assist in the task force's 5 duties; 6 7 (7) invite other experts to assist the task 8 force as necessary; 9 (8) recommend state or federal legislation necessary to address the task force's concerns; 10 (9) address other matters related to the 11 12 natural gas emergency that the chair of the task force deems necessary; 13 determine the most practicable way that (10)14 gas customers can be notified of an impending outage or service 15 interruption; and 16 (11)determine the best methods to prioritize 17 shutdown decisions during emergencies. 18 State agencies and legislative committees shall D. 19 assist the task force as needed. 20 The task force shall report its findings and Ε. 21 recommendations to the governor and the appropriate interim 22 legislative committees by August 1, 2011 and shall post its 23 report on the public regulation commission web site upon 24 completion. 25 .186008.1

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1	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONFifty thousand dollars
2	(\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
3	department of finance and administration for expenditure in
4	fiscal years 2011 and 2012 to pay the expenses of the natural
5	gas emergency investigation task force. Any unexpended or
6	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2012
7	shall revert to the general fund.
8	SECTION 3. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
9	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
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
