AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE PUBLIC ASSISTANCE ACT TO REQUIRE THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE TO MEDICAL ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS COVERAGE FOR METHADONE REPLACEMENT THERAPY TO TREAT OPIOID ADDICTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Public Assistance Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] MEDICAL ASSISTANCE--METHADONE OPIOID REPLACEMENT THERAPY BENEFIT . - -

- Through its medical assistance programs, the department shall provide recipients for whom an authorized practitioner prescribes methadone replacement therapy with coverage for methadone replacement therapy.
