AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR NEW MEXICO SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the aging and long-term services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2014 for the following purposes:

(1) four million six hundred thirteen thousand six hundred eighty-three dollars (\$4,613,683) for the six area agencies that provide senior services, including adult daycare, case management, congregate meals, home-delivered meals, in-home services, transportation and senior center services;

(2) one hundred seventy thousand nine hundred thirteen dollars (\$170,913) for volunteer programs, including foster grandparents, senior companions and retired senior
