AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; REQUIRING THAT THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT WEB SITE HAVE DIRECT LINKS TO ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR A PERSON TO START A BUSINESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 9-15-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, Chapter 297, Section 7, as amended) is amended to read:

"9-15-7. SECRETARY--ADDITIONAL DUTIES.--In addition to the secretary's responsibility for the overall supervision of the department's operation in support of the purposes of the Economic Development Department Act, the secretary shall:

- A. work with and provide staff support to the commission in formulating and implementing the state's five-year economic development plan;
 - B. advise the commission of proposed rules,

1	regulations, projects and contractual arrangements;
2	C. enter into contracts with state, federal or
3	private entities, apply for and accept any state, federal or
4	private funds or grants for such projects and accept similar
5	donations and bequests from any source;
6	D. maintain and update records on the status of all
7	completed and ongoing projects of the department;
8	E. develop, maintain and provide economic and
9	demographic information; [and]
10	F. post direct links on the department web site to
11	all documents necessary to allow a person to start a business,
12	including instructions for obtaining and registering such
13	documents, including:
14	(1) a combined reporting system identification
15	number form;
16	(2) a federal employer identification number
17	form; and
18	(3) any other document required by the federal
19	government, the state, a county, a municipality or other
20	political subdivision; and
21	$[F_{ullet}]$ G. perform such other duties as requested by
22	the commission in order to further the purposes of the Economic
23	Development Department Act."
