1 more students; provided that a school district may apply to the 2 department for a waiver of this provision if the school 3 district is unable to hire or contract with the required school 4 nurse.

5 B. The department shall, by rule, establish the 6 requirements for an instructional day, the standards for an 7 instructional hour and the standards for a full-time teacher 8 and for the equivalent thereof.

C. The provision of a school nurse in every public 9 elementary school with a MEM of three hundred or more shall be 10 phased in over a four-year period as follows, with priority 11 12 given to those public schools that serve the highest proportion of students who are eligible for free or reduced-fee lunch: 13 14 (1) effective with the 2013-2014 school year, at least one-fourth of required public elementary schools; 15 (2) effective with the 2014-2015 school year, 16 at least one-half of required public elementary schools; 17 (3) effective with the 2015-2016 school year, 18 19 at least three-fourths of required public elementary schools; 20 and (4) effective with the 2016-2017 school year, 21 all required public elementary schools, unless a waiver has 22 been approved by the department pursuant to Subsection B of 23 this section, and including any public elementary schools that 24 have a MEM lower than three hundred but that have one or more 25
