The committee shall also take 5 testimony from members of the community, including those concerned about the impact of transportation projects, the 6 7 effects of motor fuel taxation and the development of 8 transportation infrastructure. The committee shall ensure that 9 it hears testimony from representatives of New Mexico's Indian nations, tribes and pueblos. 10

G. The transportation financing committee shall meet regularly and shall make a report of its findings and recommendations for the consideration of the legislature. The report and suggested legislation shall be made available to the New Mexico legislative council on or before December 15 preceding the legislative session.

H. The legislative council service shall provide staff for the committee.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
