11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION OF THE  
12 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO FUND A TRANSITIONAL  
13 LIVING PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS AND RUNAWAY YOUTH.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars  
17 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local  
18 government division of the department of finance and  
19 administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2014 to provide a  
20 transitional living program in Bernalillo county that offers  
21 temporary shelter, board, living skills education, behavioral  
22 health services and social services to children who are aging  
23 out of foster care and to homeless and runaway youth who are  
24 sixteen to twenty-one years old. Any unexpected or  
25 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2014
