11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE INDIAN AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT TO
12 PROVIDE TRAINING TO JUDGES AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT REGARDING
13 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred thousand dollars
17 (\$300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the Indian
18 affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2014 to
19 contract with an organization with decades of Indian law and
20 policy experience to develop and provide training to tribal
21 court judges, magistrate judges and local law enforcement on
22 the complexities of handling domestic violence cases occurring
23 across multiple jurisdictions and on related policies, laws and
24 court development. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
25 remaining at the end of fiscal year 2014 shall revert to the
