11 RELATING TO DNA IDENTIFICATION; REQUIRING THE CORRECTIONS  
12 DEPARTMENT TO ASSESS AND COLLECT A DNA FEE FROM COVERED  
13 OFFENDERS WHO ARE TRANSFERRED TO NEW MEXICO PURSUANT TO AN  
14 INTERSTATE COMPACT.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 SECTION 1. Section 29-16-11 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,  
18 Chapter 105, Section 11) is amended to read:

19 "29-16-11. ASSESSMENT [~~OF~~]~~--COLLECTION--DNA FEE.--~~[~~On and~~  
20 ~~after the effective date of the DNA Identification Act~~]

21 A. When a covered offender is convicted, the court  
22 shall assess a DNA fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) in  
23 addition to any other fee, restitution or fine. The [~~fee shall~~  
24 ~~be deposited in the fund.~~] corrections department shall collect  
25 the DNA fee from the covered offender for deposit in the fund.
