#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 67 declares March 7, 2013 “New Mexico MESA Day” at the House of Representatives. HM 67 also recognizes New Mexico MESA for its dedication to preparing minority students for careers in mathematics, engineering and the sciences.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HM 67 notes that New Mexico MESA is a non-profit mathematics, engineering and science program that works in partnership with schools and universities and promotes educational enrichment for pre-college students from historically underrepresented ethnic groups. New Mexico MESA is in 100 schools statewide and provides thousands of junior and high school students with year-round support and guidance.
