SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Survivors of Suicide is a nonprofit volunteer organization that assists people suffering the loss of a loved one by suicide. The organization meets four times a month and is open all individuals who have lost someone through suicide. Mental health practitioners often attend to provide assistance in coping with the loss.
