14	WHEREAS, Valencia county is part of the Rio Abajo; and
15	WHEREAS, Valencia county is the home of the largest
16	matanza in the United States, and the matanza is a symbol of
17	the rich Spanish heritage of the Rio Grande valley; and
18	WHEREAS, Valencia county is the home of the famous Tome
19	Land Grant, which the king of Spain granted to thirty families
20	in 1739; and
21	WHEREAS, the village of Los Lunas was founded by Spaniards
22	in the seventeenth century; and
23	WHEREAS, Belen is officially known as "Nuestra Señora de
24	Belen", or "Our Lady of Belen"; and
25	WHEREAS, Belen means "Bethlehem" in Spanish; and

1 WHEREAS, Belen was a strategic point along the Camino 2 Real, also known as the "Royal Road", which carved a trade 3 route south into Mexico; and WHEREAS, Belen has gained the nickname "hub city" because 4 of the Belen cutoff of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe 5 railway, now known as the Burlington Northern Santa Fe railway; 6 7 and WHEREAS, Bosque Farms was a destination for relocated dust 8 9 bowl refugees; and WHEREAS, Bosque Farms strives to be a sparsely populated, 10 agricultural community; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Peralta was the site of a minor engagement during the American civil war; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the newly incorporated Rio Communities is home to Valencia county's only golf course, Tierra del Sol; and 15 WHEREAS, Valencia county is home to decalogue stone, which 16 contains an inscription that is interpreted to be an abridged 17 version of the ten commandments in a form of the Paleo-Hebrew 18 19 alphabet; and 20 WHEREAS, Valencia county houses two museums, the Belen Harvey house museum and the Los Lunas museum of heritage and 21 arts; and 22 WHEREAS, Valencia county is home to parts of the Cibola 23 national forest and the Manzano wilderness; and 24 WHEREAS, Valencia county is renowned for its agriculture; 25 .191639.3 - 2 -
