10 A JOINT MEMORIAL

11 PROCLAIMING SUPPORT BY THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATURE FOR THE
12 FORMATION OF A PRESIDENTIAL YOUTH COUNCIL.

14 WHEREAS, the unique perspectives and insights of young
15 people, especially young people who have previously
16 participated in public policy-related programs, outreach
17 initiatives, internships or fellowship opportunities, are
18 essential to ensure that investments made by the federal
19 government in youth services are effective and efficient; and

20 WHEREAS, the existing outreach and engagement mechanisms
21 of the federal government are designed in ways that inhibit
22 participation and lead to the underrepresentation of young
23 people in the policymaking process; and

24 WHEREAS, numerous members of congress, former governors
25 and the New Mexico legislature have formed the youth alliance;

2 WHEREAS, the mayors of both Santa Fe and Albuquerque have
3 youth councils that have proven to be an effective means of
4 receiving input from young people, which leads to more
5 effective and efficient policies; and

6 WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature calls on the president
7 of the United States to establish a presidential youth council
8 to create recommendations that advise the president and the
9 president's administration on the perspectives of young people,
10 making public policy-related youth programs more efficient and
11 effective; and

12 WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislature recommends that
13 members of the presidential youth council be youths between the
14 ages of sixteen and twenty-four who can constructively
15 contribute to public policy deliberations and conduct outreach
16 to solicit the views and perspectives of youth peers; and

17 WHEREAS, members of the presidential youth council are to
18 be appointed by leaders of the majority and minority parties in
19 the United States house of representatives and the United
20 States senate, as well as by the president of the United
21 States;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
23 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it support the creation of a
24 presidential youth council; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
