WHEREAS, over one thousand individuals volunteer at YMCAs each year, making the YMCA one of the largest volunteer-led and -driven organizations in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, each YMCA is governed by a local volunteer board of directors who give generously of their time, money and effort in order that New Mexico residents may grow as responsible members of their families and communities and develop self-confidence and self-respect, as well as an awareness of the rights and worth of every individual; and

WHEREAS, each local volunteer board of directors also appreciates that physical and mental health are divine gifts that should be maintained through healthy living and spiritual growth, and serving on the board allows volunteers to develop and use their capacities for leadership; and

WHEREAS, nearly two hundred forty thousand dollars (\$240,000) was awarded in financial aid so that everyone, regardless of ability to pay, could participate in the Y, and the YMCA financial aid program depends wholly upon continued
