A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO DIRECT THE
APPROPRIATE INTERIM COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A LONG-TERM FUNDING
PLAN FOR FOREST AND WATERSHED RESTORATION WORK IN NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, New Mexico needs a large-scale forest and
watershed restoration program; and

WHEREAS, the urgency of the situation has been established
in the New Mexico forest action plan, New Mexico forest and
watershed health plan and the federal agency land and resource
management plans; and

WHEREAS, scientists and stakeholders agree that the
current level of active management on forest lands is
insufficient to address the scope, scale and pace needed to
restore these forests to a more resilient condition; and

WHEREAS, uncharacteristically large and intense wildfires

1 and insect epidemics are affecting federal forest lands in
2 acreages that dwarf the agencies' accomplishments in actively
3 managing forests to improve their resiliency; and

4 WHEREAS, if New Mexico waits for a federal solution, it
5 will be too late; and

6 WHEREAS, the state needs a coordinated, multi-partner
7 approach that leverages each federal dollar and pools revenue
8 from diverse state, local and Native American sources as well
9 as businesses and the private sector; and

10 WHEREAS, the benefits of accelerated forest and watershed
11 restoration are numerous, including secure water sources;
12 resilient forests and habitat for wildlife; and hunting,
13 fishing and outdoor recreation opportunities as well as New
14 Mexico tourism and creation of jobs and economic development in
15 rural communities; and

16 WHEREAS, the alternative, which would be to take no
17 action, will result in damage to forests and water sources for
18 generations to come;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico
21 legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate
22 interim committee of the legislature to develop a long-term
23 funding plan for federal, state, local and tribal agencies and
24 diverse stakeholders to cooperate on forest and watershed
25 restoration work in New Mexico; and
