A MEMORIAL

DECLARING FEBRUARY 3, 2014 "GUADALUPE HIDALGO TREATY DAY" AT
THE SENATE, RECOGNIZING THE SIXTEENTH ANNUAL CELEBRATION OF
GUADALUPE HIDALGO TREATY DAY AND COMMEMORATING THE
ONE-HUNDRED-SIXTY-SIXTH-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF THE SIGNING OF THE
TREATY OF GUADALUPE HIDALGO BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF
AMERICA AND THE ESTADOS UNIDOS MEXICANOS.

WHEREAS, on February 2, 1848, the United States of America
and the United Mexican States signed the peace treaty known as
the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo at the main altar of the old
cathedral of Guadalupe at the villa Hidalgo to end the war
between the two nations; and

WHEREAS, Article VI of the United States constitution
affirms that treaties are the supreme law of the land; and

WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 5 of the constitution of New

1 Mexico states that the rights guaranteed to the people of New
2 Mexico under the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo shall be preserved
3 inviolate; and

4 WHEREAS, Spanish, Mexican and pueblo community land
5 grants throughout New Mexico have continued to use the treaty
6 to protect existing and traditional common lands and pursue
7 justice in the recovery of the former common lands; and

8 WHEREAS, the New Mexico land grant forum initiated the
9 first-ever Guadalupe Hidalgo Treaty Day at the New Mexico
10 legislature to commemorate the one-hundred-fifty-year
11 anniversary of the signing of the treaty, and the New Mexico
12 land grant council now continues the tradition annually; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12-5-10 NMSA 1978, February
14 2 of each year is set apart and known as "Guadalupe Hidalgo
15 treaty day" in New Mexico; and

16 WHEREAS, the senate, in session February 3, 2014, wishes
17 to extend congratulations and honor this historic event;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
19 OF NEW MEXICO that it recognize February 3, 2014 as the
20 sixteenth annual celebration of Guadalupe Hidalgo Treaty Day
21 and declare February 3, 2014 "Guadalupe Hidalgo Treaty Day" at
22 the senate; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that state and federal legislative
24 support for all Spanish and Mexican community land grants and
25 Native American pueblos should continue far into the future;
