AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LAW; INCREASING THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR
ENTICEMENT OF A CHILD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 30-9-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963,
Chapter 303, Section 9-10) is amended to read:

"30-9-1. ENTICEMENT OF CHILD.--

A. Enticement of child consists of:

~~[A.]~~ (1) enticing, persuading or attempting to
persuade a child under the age of sixteen years to enter any
vehicle, building, room or secluded place with intent to commit
an act ~~[which]~~ that would constitute a crime under Chapter 30,
Article 9 ~~[of the Criminal Code]~~ NMSA 1978; or

~~[B.]~~ (2) having possession of a child under
the age of sixteen years in any vehicle, building, room or

1 secluded place with intent to commit an act [~~which~~] that would
2 constitute a crime under Chapter 30, Article 9 [~~of the Criminal~~
3 ~~Code~~] NMSA 1978.

4 B. Whoever commits enticement of child is guilty of
5 a [~~misdemeanor~~]:

6 (1) fourth degree felony if the child is at
7 least thirteen but under sixteen years of age; or

8 (2) third degree felony if the child is under
9 thirteen years of age."

10 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**--The effective date of the
11 provisions of this act is July 1, 2015.
