AN ACT
RELATING TO TRADE PRACTICES; REQUIRING THE USE OF CHILDRESISTANT PACKAGING FOR NICOTINE LIQUID; PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] CHILD-RESISTANT PACKAGING FOR NICOTINE LIQUID.--
A. No person shall sell or offer for sale in this state any nicotine liquid unless the nicotine liquid is contained in child-resistant packaging.
B. The attorney general may institute a civil action in district court for a violation of the provisions of this section or to prevent a violation of the provisions of this section. Relief may include a permanent or temporary injunction, a restraining order or any other appropriate order, including a civil penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars . 198684.1
(\$1,000) for each violation.
C. As used in this section:
(1) "child-resistant packaging" means packaging that is designed or constructed to make it significantly difficult for a child under five years of age to open or obtain a toxic or harmful amount of the substance contained therein;
(2) "electronic delivery device" means any electronic device, whether composed of a heating element and battery or an electronic circuit, that provides a vapor of nicotine, the use or inhalation of which simulates smoking; and
(3) "nicotine liquid" means a liquid solution containing nicotine in any concentration that is intended for human consumption via an electronic delivery device.
