11 RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES; ESTABLISHING A MOBILE SHOWER  
12 FACILITY PILOT PROGRAM TO SERVE HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS; MAKING AN  
13 APPROPRIATION.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. MOBILE SHOWER FACILITY PILOT PROGRAM--DATA  
17 COLLECTION--REPORTING.--

18 A. The New Mexico mortgage finance authority shall  
19 establish a one-year pilot project in a class A county with a  
20 population of at least six hundred thousand individuals to  
21 provide a mobile facility that travels within the designated  
22 county to offer showers and bathroom facilities to allow  
23 homeless individuals to tend to their personal hygiene. The  
24 New Mexico mortgage finance authority shall collect data  
25 related to the following:

- 1 (1) the number of individuals served;
- 2 (2) the number of staff required to implement
- 3 the pilot program; and
- 4 (3) the cost of operating the program.

5 B. The New Mexico mortgage finance authority shall  
6 report the data and make projections as to the cost of  
7 implementing the mobile shower facility services for homeless  
8 individuals statewide as well as any programmatic  
9 recommendations it has for statewide implementation of the  
10 mobile shower facility program to the legislative health and  
11 human services committee and the legislative finance committee  
12 by November 1, 2016.

13 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars  
14 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New  
15 Mexico mortgage finance authority for expenditure in fiscal  
16 year 2016 to fund the costs of operating a mobile shower  
17 facility pilot program, collecting data and reporting on the  
18 collected data pursuant to Section 1 of this act. Any  
19 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
20 fiscal year 2016 shall revert to the general fund.
