AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR RATE
INCREASES TO FAMILY INFANT TODDLER PROVIDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Eight million two hundred thousand dollars
(\$8,200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 2016 as
follows:

(1) one million five hundred thousand dollars
(\$1,500,000) to fund provider rate increases recommended in the
2003 cost study on family infant toddler services; and

(2) six million seven hundred thousand dollars
(\$6,700,000) to fund additional rate increases to cover the
increased cost of providing family infant toddler services as a
