17	A. Every law enforcement agency that has a special
18	weapons and tactics team or similar law enforcement unit shall
19	annually file with the secretary of public safety, on or before
20	May l of each calendar year, a report regarding all deployments
21	of that agency's team during the previous calendar year.
22	B. The report required pursuant to Subsection A of
23	this section shall include at least the following information
24	for each team deployment:

4	a similar agency of the state or a political subdivision of the
5	state authorized to enforce criminal statutes;
6	(2) "law enforcement officer" means a state or
7	municipal police officer, county sheriff, deputy sheriff,
8	conservation officer, motor transportation enforcement officer
9	or other state employee authorized by state law to enforce
10	criminal statutes; and
11	(3) "special weapons and tactics team" or
12	"team" means a group of law enforcement officers that is
13	utilized for situations that require increased personnel,
14	firepower or specialized tactics.
