### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 348 adds language to Section 4-39-5 NMSA 198 to provide that a board of county commissioners may increase annual additional incentive pay for appraisers in the office of the county assessor as follows:

- \$1,500 for holding an “appraiser 2” certificate;
- \$2,500 for holding an “appraiser 3” certificate;
- \$3,000 for holding an “appraiser 4” certificate.

Under current law, the additional incentive pay for holding a certificate of appraiser 2, 3, or 4 is limited to an additional \$1,000 per year.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Enactment of the provisions of HB 348 may have fiscal implications for New Mexico counties, but the extent of the impact was not reported by the counties.
