RECOGNIZING THE EMPLOYER SUPPORT OF THE GUARD AND RESERVE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the mission of the employer support of the guard and reserve program is to promote a culture in which all New Mexico employers support and value the military service of their employees and citizen soldiers; and

WHEREAS, the employer support of the guard and reserve program recognizes the outstanding support of New Mexico employers for their citizen soldiers by increasing awareness of the federal Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment
