WHEREAS, Grant county is home to western New Mexico university, where its museum houses the world's foremost collections of ancient Mimbres pottery; and

10 WHEREAS, Grant county is New Mexico's richest county for 11 mining; and

WHEREAS, Grant county is where, in 1866, company B of the one hundred twenty-fifth United States colored infantry was established at Fort Bayard; and

WHEREAS, Grant county is honored to be the home of many veterans, including members of New Mexico's two hundredth coast artillery regiment, many of whom were subjected to the Bataan death march; and

WHEREAS, Grant county hosts the tour of the Gila, New Mexico's premier cycling stage race that attracts national and international teams and boosts awareness and use of the trail of the mountain spirits national scenic byway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 28, 2015 be proclaimed "Grant County Day" in the senate; and
