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17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 11, Section 1
19	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
20	"The "public regulation commission" is created. The
21	commission shall consist of [five] <u>three</u> members [elected from
22	districts provided by law for staggered four-year terms
23	beginning on January 1 of the year following their election;
24	provided that those chosen at the first general election after
25	the adoption of this section shall immediately classify

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1	themselves by lot, so that two of them shall hold office for
2	two years and three of them for four years; and further
3	provided that, after serving two terms, members shall be
4	ineligible to hold office as a commission member until one full
5	term has intervened] appointed by the governor with the advice
6	and consent of the senate, from districts as provided by law;
7	provided that the initial districts from which the appointments
8	are made following the adoption of this amendment shall be the
9	same as the state's congressional districts to serve a
10	four-year term. No more than two commissioners shall be
11	members of the same political party at the time of their
12	appointment. Commissioners shall be appointed for staggered
13	four-year terms; provided that two of the first three
14	commissioners appointed shall be appointed to a two-year term
15	and the third shall be appointed to a four-year term.
16	<u>Commissioners are state officers.</u> The legislature shall
17	provide, by law, [increased] qualifications [for commissioners]
18	and continuing education requirements for commissioners. [The
19	increased qualifications provided by this 2012 amendment shall
20	apply to public regulation commissioners elected at the general
21	election in 2014 and subsequent elections and to commissioners
22	appointed to fill a vacancy at any time after July 1, 2013.]
23	No commissioner [or candidate for the commission] shall accept
24	anything of value from a person or entity whose charges for
25	services to the public are regulated by the commission."
