

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING JANUARY 21, 2016 "OFFICER DANIEL SCOTT WEBSTER DAY"
3 IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, on October 29, 2015, Albuquerque police
6 department Officer Daniel Scott Webster succumbed to gunshot
7 wounds sustained in the line of duty and ended his watch; and

8 WHEREAS, Officer Webster left a legacy that is filled
9 with honor, excellence, service to country and service to
10 others; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Webster was a highly decorated United
12 States army paratrooper who served in multiple deployments
13 and combat tours, including Panama, Bosnia, Africa, the first
14 Gulf war and several tours to Iraq, Afghanistan and Kuwait;
15 and

16 WHEREAS, after retiring from twenty years of dignified
17 military service, he continued to serve his community by
18 joining the Albuquerque police department; and

19 WHEREAS, Officer Webster served nearly nine years with
20 the Albuquerque police department in several capacities,
21 including detective and patrol officer in southeast
22 Albuquerque; and

23 WHEREAS, in 2013, Officer Webster was named Albuquerque
24 police department uniformed officer of the year in
25 recognition of his determination, motivation and leadership

1 among his peers; and

2 WHEREAS, Albuquerque police chief Gorden Eden said
3 Officer Webster "was the very best example of a life
4 committed to public service, through his service to our
5 country and to our community"; and

6 WHEREAS, Officer Webster was known as a good man, a
7 loving son, father and grandfather, a friend to many and a
8 dedicated husband above all else; and

9 WHEREAS, Officer Webster is survived by his mother,
10 Gayle Hanafin and husband, John; his father, Daniel Arthur
11 Webster and stepmother, Sabina; his wife, Michelle
12 Carlino-Webster; his children, Rebecca Ingham and husband,
13 Johnny, Danielle Modrow and Ashleigh Webster; his
14 grandmother, Eleanor Bain; grandchildren, Addyson, Jaxson,
15 Sophia, Raelynn, Quincy, Braydon and Patrick; his brother,
16 Doug Webster and wife, Christy and their two children, Adam
17 and Elizabeth; his half-brothers, Joshua Webster and Nathan
18 Webster; and his beloved canine friend, Sage;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
20 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 21,
21 2016 be declared "Officer Daniel Scott Webster Day" in the
22 house of representatives in honor of the dedicated, selfless
23 service Officer Webster gave his country and community and
24 for making the ultimate sacrifice in his commitment to
25 protect and serve; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that condolences be extended to
2 the family and friends of Officer Webster, an honorable and
3 heroic New Mexican; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
5 transmitted to the family of Officer Webster.
