2 DECLARING JANUARY 28, 2016 "SOUTHWEST COMMUNITY SCHOOL
3 COLLABORATIVE DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, the Southwest community school collaborative
6 works to reduce the number of students who go from school to
7 prison by involving students, parents and community programs
8 in the lives of students to promote positive relationships
9 among youths, families and adults; and

10 WHEREAS, the goal of the Southwest community school
11 collaborative is to provide students who have violated the
12 law or have negative behaviors with support services as an
13 alternative to arrest or suspension; and

14 WHEREAS, the Southwest community school collaborative
15 engages families, schools and community partners in advancing
16 the welfare of students and in providing opportunities for
17 successful educational outcomes; and

18 WHEREAS, the Southwest community school collaborative
19 has created an open environment for communities and families
20 to help children become successful adults; and

21 WHEREAS, the Southwest community school collaborative
22 works with the administration of Atrisco heritage academy
23 high school in Albuquerque to reduce suspension and dropout
24 rates and to promote positive student success outcomes; and

25 WHEREAS, the Atrisco heritage academy high school staff

1 strives to provide students with the educational skills to
2 become productive citizens;

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
4 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 28,
5 2016 be declared "Southwest Community School Collaborative
6 Day", a day of communal efforts in the house of
7 representatives for supporting students, families and staff;

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
10 transmitted to the principal of Atrisco heritage academy high
11 school and the resource officer of the Albuquerque public
12 school district police department.
