

1 A MEMORIAL

2 CONGRATULATING THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO SCHOOL OF LAW TAX
3 TEAM ON WINNING THE FIFTEENTH ANNUAL AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION
4 SECTION OF TAXATION LAW STUDENT TAX CHALLENGE.

6 WHEREAS, as an alternative to traditional moot court
7 competitions, the American bar association sponsors a law
8 student tax challenge that asks two-person teams of students
9 to solve a cutting-edge tax problem and complex business
10 problem that might arise in everyday tax practice; and

11 WHEREAS, teams write a memorandum to a senior partner
12 and a client letter explaining their solution, and each team
13 presents its solutions to a panel of judges during oral
14 defense rounds; and

15 WHEREAS, university of New Mexico law students
16 Frank Cardoza and Scott Woody won first place in the juris
17 doctor candidate division of the fifteenth annual law student
18 tax challenge hosted by the section of taxation of the
19 American bar association, held on January 29, 2016; and

20 WHEREAS, Frank Cardoza and Scott Woody also won best
21 written submission during the competition; and

22 WHEREAS, Professor Mary Leto Pareja coached the team to
23 success; and

24 WHEREAS, the team was supported during its preparation
25 for the oral defense rounds by Professor Robert J. Desiderio

1 and Adjunct Professor Andrew Weinstein of the university of
2 New Mexico school of law; and

3 WHEREAS, R. Tracy Sprouls and Robert Lucero of the
4 Rodey law firm, both alumni of the university of New Mexico
5 school of law, also supported the team; and

6 WHEREAS, forty-three teams from law schools all over the
7 country competed in the juris doctor candidate division of
8 the competition; and

9 WHEREAS, the team of Frank Cardoza and Scott Woody is
10 the first university of New Mexico team to win the
11 competition;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE
13 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that congratulations be extended to
14 Frank Cardoza and Scott Woody on winning first place in the
15 juris doctor candidate division of the fifteenth annual law
16 student tax challenge; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Professor Mary Leto Pareja,
18 Professor Robert J. Desiderio, Adjunct Professor
19 Andrew Weinstein and R. Tracy Sprouls and Robert Lucero be
20 recognized for coaching the winning team; and
