### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 88 requests the AG to establish a special excessive force unit with statewide jurisdiction dedicated to investigating and, when warranted, prosecuting cases concerning the alleged use of excessive force by law enforcement officers.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The number of potential investigations and AGO time and resource required to implement the new unit is unknown. Any additional costs associated with the new unit would have to be absorbed in the current operating budget.
