WHEREAS, on October 29, 2015, Albuquerque police
department Officer Daniel Scott Webster succumbed to gunshot
wounds sustained in the line of duty and ended his watch; and

WHEREAS, Officer Webster left a legacy that is filled with
honor, excellence, service to country and service to others;

WHEREAS, Officer Webster was a highly decorated United
States army paratrooper who served in multiple deployments and
combat tours, including Panama, Bosnia, Africa, the first Gulf
war and several tours to Iraq, Afghanistan and Kuwait; and

WHEREAS, after retiring from twenty years of dignified
military service, he continued to serve his community by

13 WHEREAS, Officer Webster was known as a good man, a loving
14 son, father and grandfather, a friend to many and a dedicated
15 husband above all else; and

16 WHEREAS, Officer Webster is survived by his mother, Gayle
17 Hanafin and husband, John; his father, Daniel Arthur Webster
18 and stepmother, Sabina; his wife, Michelle Carlino-Webster; his
19 children, Rebecca Ingham and husband, Johnny, Danielle Modrow
20 and Ashleigh Webster; his grandmother, Eleanor Bain;
21 grandchildren, Addyson, Jaxson, Sophia, Raelynn, Quincy,
