AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE LYNN AND ERIN
COMPASSIONATE USE ACT TO BAN MEDICAL CANNABIS POSSESSION LIMITS
FOR LICENSED PRODUCERS AND ESTABLISH A LICENSURE FEE LIMIT FOR
LICENSED PRODUCERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Lynn and Erin

Compassionate Use Act is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ LICENSED PRODUCERS--BAN ON PLANT
POSSESSION LIMITATION--FEE.--

A. The department shall not limit the number of
plants that a licensed producer may possess.

B. On an annual basis and in accordance with
department rules, an applicant for licensure shall submit an
application for licensure or renewal of licensure. The

1 application shall include a production plan that specifies the
2 number of plants the applicant intends to possess during the
3 upcoming fiscal year.
