Honorable Speaker Egolf and Members of the House:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return HOUSE BILL 86, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Third Legislature, First Session, 2017.

Caregivers serve an integral and undervalued role in New Mexico. Across the state, caregivers unselfishly give up their own time and needs in order to aid their loved ones. While I recognize the tremendous importance of caregivers in this state, HB 86 is vague and would have significant unintended consequences that would hamper business efficiency and place undue burdens on businesses.

For these reasons, I hereby veto House Bill 86.
