AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS
THROUGHOUT NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the
general fund to the aging and long-term services department for
expenditure in fiscal year 2018 to fund the following programs
and services:

(1) one million two hundred fifty-seven
thousand, nine hundred ninety-eight dollars (\$1,257,998) for
the following senior services delivered through the four area
agencies on aging:

- (a) adult day care;
- (b) case management;

- 1 (c) congregate meals;
- 2 (d) home-delivered meals;
- 3 (e) in-home services;
- 4 (f) transportation; and
- 5 (g) senior center services;

6 (2) one hundred three thousand dollars
7 (\$103,000) for volunteer programs, including foster
8 grandparents, senior companions and retired senior volunteers;

9 (3) thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000) to
10 fund evidence-based Alzheimer's programming in northern New
11 Mexico; and

12 (4) thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000) to
13 fund competitive athletic and fitness programming for seniors.

14 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
15 at the end of fiscal year 2018 shall revert to the general
16 fund.
