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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 7-1-6.40 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
18	Chapter 182, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"7-1-6.40. DISTRIBUTION OF LIQUOR EXCISE TAXLOCAL DWI
20	GRANT FUNDCERTAIN MUNICIPALITIESLOTTERY TUITION FUND
21	A. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1
22	NMSA 1978 shall be made to the local DWI grant fund in an
23	amount equal to the following percentages of the net receipts
24	attributable to the liquor excise tax:
25	(1) prior to July 1, 2015, forty-one and one-

half percent;

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2 (2) from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018,
3 forty-six percent; and

4 (3) on and after July 1, 2018, forty-one and5 one-half percent.

Β. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 6 7 NMSA 1978 of twenty thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$20,750) monthly from the net receipts attributable to the 8 9 liquor excise tax shall be made to a municipality that is located in a class A county and that has a population according 10 to the most recent federal decennial census of more than thirty 11 12 thousand but less than sixty thousand. The distribution pursuant to this subsection shall be used by the municipality 13 only for the provision of alcohol treatment and rehabilitation 14 services for street inebriates. 15

C. From July 1, 2015 through June 30, [2017] <u>2020</u>, a distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 NMSA 1978 of [thirty-nine] thirty percent of the net receipts attributable to the liquor excise tax shall be made to the lottery tuition fund."

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
