AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE CODE TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE RECOGNIZING THE CHILE PEPPER, THE FRUIT FROM CAPSICUM ANNUUM; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] CHILE PEPPER SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.--

- A. The division shall issue a standardized special registration plate with a logo specified in Section 66-3-424 NMSA 1978 indicating support for the chile pepper, the fruit from Capsicum annuum, and displaying the image of one or more chile peppers.
- B. For a fee of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00), which .206815.1

shall be in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees, the owner of a vehicle may apply for issuance of a chile pepper special registration plate. The owner shall apply and pay the fee each year to retain and renew the chile pepper special registration plate.

- Revenue from the additional fee for a chile C. pepper special registration plate shall be distributed as follows:
- ten dollars (\$10.00) of the additional fee (1) collected shall be retained by and is appropriated to the department to defray the cost of making and issuing the chile pepper special registration plate; and
- twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) of the (2) additional fee collected shall be distributed to and is appropriated to the farm and ranch heritage museum for educational programs."

EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the SECTION 2. provisions of this act is July 1, 2017.
