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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 10 NMSA 1978 is  
17 enacted to read:

18 "[NEW MATERIAL] DIVERSITY IN STATE GOVERNMENT--COLLECTION  
19 OF STATISTICAL DATA.--

20 A. A state agency, including a department,  
21 institution, board, bureau, commission or district of the  
22 executive, legislative or judicial branch of the state, shall  
23 collect and maintain statistical data on the racial, ethnic and  
24 gender composition of its workforce, including elected and  
25 appointed officers and employees. Each agency shall annually,

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1 on or before July 1, provide a report of the statistical data  
2 collected to the state personnel office.

3 B. The state personnel office shall aggregate the  
4 statistical data reported by the state agencies pursuant to  
5 Subsection A of this section and shall publish the data to the  
6 New Mexico sunshine portal website."

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
