16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 7-1-6.43 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
18	Chapter 86, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"7-1-6.43. DISTRIBUTION TO LEGISLATIVE RETIREMENT FUND
20	A. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1
21	NMSA 1978 shall be made to the legislative retirement fund in
22	an amount equal to [seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) or,
23	if larger] one-twelfth of the amount necessary to pay out the
24	retirement benefits due under state legislator member coverage
25	plan 2 and Paragraph (2) of Subsection C of Section 10-11-41

2 Β. In December [2003 and in each December 3 thereafter] of each year, the public employees retirement association, with the assistance of the legislative council 4 service, shall determine the amount of those retirement 5 benefits for the succeeding calendar year. [If the monthly 6 7 average exceeds seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000)] The 8 association shall *immediately* notify [*immediately*] the 9 department of the [average] amount. That [average] amount divided by twelve shall be [the amount] distributed pursuant to 10 Subsection A of this section [as of] at the end of each [month] 11 12 of the twelve consecutive months beginning with the December in which the determination was made." 13

SECTION 2. Section 10-11A-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, Chapter 263, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"10-11A-3. VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT FUND--CREATION--TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE FIRE PROTECTION FUND.--

A. There is created the "volunteer firefighters retirement fund" in the state treasury. All annuities and benefits in lieu of annuities shall be paid from the fund as provided in the Volunteer Firefighters Retirement Act.

B. Beginning in fiscal year 1998, <u>but not in fiscal</u> <u>years 2018 through 2020</u>, the state treasurer shall transfer annually on or before the last day of July seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) plus an additional two hundred .207349.1
