AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EDUCATION; AMENDING THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE TO REQUIRE THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO ADOPT ACADEMIC CONTENT AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS FOR PERFORMING AND VISUAL ARTS AND NATIONAL PHYSICAL EDUCATION STANDARDS AND TO REQUIRE THE REVISION AND UPDATING OF THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION STANDARDS AS NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED STANDARDS EVOLVE AND CHANGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 22-2C-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003, Chapter 153, Section 12, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-2C-3. ACADEMIC CONTENT AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS-DEPARTMENT POWERS AND DUTIES.--

A. The department shall adopt academic content and performance standards for grades one through twelve in the following areas:

8	(6) physical education.
9	B. The department shall update physical education
10	content standards in department rule to reflect current
11	nationally recognized standards and practices and regularly
12	revise and update physical education content standards as they
13	change.

15	performance standards in other subject areas.
16	[C.] D. Academic content and performance standards
17	shall be sufficiently academically challenging to meet or
18	exceed any applicable federal requirements.
19	$[\frac{\mathbf{D}_{\bullet}}{\mathbf{E}_{\bullet}}]$ The department shall measure the
20	performance of every public school in New Mexico."
