17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. A new section of the Crime Victims Reparation
19	Act is enacted to read:

23	A. The "child abuse homicide review team" is

The child abuse homicide review team shall: 4 (1) review trends and patterns of child-abuse-5 related homicides in New Mexico; 6 7 (2) evaluate the responses of government and nongovernment service delivery systems and offer 8 9 recommendations for improvement of the responses; identify and characterize high-risk groups 10 (3) for the purpose of recommending developments in public policy; 11 12 (4) collect statistical data in a consistent and uniform manner on the occurrence of child-abuse-related 13 14 homicides; and improve collaboration among tribal, state (5) 15 and local agencies and organizations to develop initiatives to 16 prevent child abuse. 17 An organization, institution, agency or person D. 18 19 may share information and records that are otherwise protected 20 by law from disclosure if the information and records are shared only for the purpose of a review of child-abuse-related 21 homicides by the child abuse homicide review team. 22 Ε. 1 the purpose of reviewing child-abuse-related homicides pursuant 2 to this section: and 3 (2) all communications made by child abuse homicide review team members or other persons during a review 4 conducted by the team of a child-abuse-related homicide. 5 F. The following persons shall honor the 6 7 confidentiality requirements of this section and shall not make disclosure of any matter related to the team's review of a 8 9 child-abuse-related homicide, except pursuant to appropriate court orders: 10 child abuse homicide review team members; (1)11 12 (2) persons who provide records, reports or other information to the team for the purpose of reviewing 13 child-abuse-related homicides; and 14 (3) persons who participate in a review 15 conducted by the team. 16 Nothing in this section shall prevent the 17 G. discovery or admissibility of any evidence that is otherwise 18 discoverable or admissible merely because the evidence was 19 20 presented during the review of a child-abuse-related homicide pursuant to this section. 21 Η. 2 I. An organization, institution, agency or person that provides testimony, records, reports or other information 3 to the child abuse homicide review team for the purpose of 4 reviewing child-abuse-related homicides shall not be subject to 5 civil liability for providing the testimony, records, reports 6 7 or other information to the team; provided that the organization, institution, agency or person acts in good faith, 8 9 without malice and in compliance with other state or federal 10 law. At least sixty days prior to the convening of J. 11 12 each regular session of the legislature, the child abuse homicide review team shall transmit a report of its activities 13 14 pursuant to this section to: the governor; (1) 15 the New Mexico legislative council; (2) 16 the chief justice of the supreme court; 17 (3) the secretary of public safety; 18 (4) the secretary of children, youth and 19 (5) 20 families; the secretary of health; (6) 21 (7) the secretary of human services; 22 the New Mexico attorney general; and (8) 23 any other persons the team deems (9) 24 appropriate." 25 .206048.4 - 5 -

SECTION 2. A new section of the Abuse and Neglect Act is
 enacted to read:

3 "[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] CHILD-ABUSE-RELATED HOMICIDE--INDEPENDENT 4 INVESTIGATION--REPORT.--

A. Whenever a child-abuse-related homicide occurs,
the attorney general may request that the secretary of
children, youth and families appoint an independent
investigator to investigate the homicide.

9 Β. Within thirty days of receipt of a request by 10 the attorney general as provided in Subsection A of this 11 section, the secretary shall appoint an independent 12 investigator to determine whether, with respect to the child 13 victim, any person failed to make a notification required by 14 law regarding alleged abuse of the child and whether any technical, administrative or procedural issues prevented a 15 16 required notification from being made, received or acted upon.

C. An independent investigator appointed in accordance with this section shall submit a report on the completed investigation to the secretary, the attorney general and the child abuse homicide review team."
