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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the Public Assistance Act is
17	enacted to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] MEDICAL ASSISTANCENURSING FACILITIES
19	INSTITUTIONAL CAREMINIMUM STAFFING
20	A. As of July 1, 2017, the department shall require
21	any nursing facility that receives reimbursement through the
22	state's medical assistance program for providing
23	institutionalized care in a medicaid-qualifying bed to meet
24	minimum nursing department staffing standards pursuant to which
25	each patient shall be provided with at least four and one-tenth
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1 hours of nursing care per patient day.

As used in this section, "nursing care" means 2 Β. care provided by a registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, 3 4 nurse aide or nurse aide trainee."

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Four million six hundred ninety-three thousand two hundred thirty-seven dollars 7 (\$4,693,237) is appropriated from the general fund to the human 8 services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2018 to provide reimbursement to nursing facilities providing institutionalized care in medicaid-qualifying beds sufficient 10 to meet the staffing standards established pursuant to Section 12 l of this act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2018 shall revert to the general fund.

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
