DECLARING MARCH 8, 2017 "AUTISM DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, parents, professionals, self-advocates and volunteers devote countless hours to improve the quality of life of those affected by autism; and

WHEREAS, early intervention, evidence-based practices and proven support systems greatly improve the outcomes and reduce the lifelong costs of care of individuals with autism and their families; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico celebrates and recognizes the valuable contributions to its communities, businesses, technologies and cultures made by people with autism; and

2 volunteers working to promote a greater understanding of

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
6 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that March 8, 2017
7 be declared "Autism Day" in the house of representatives; and
