SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

SB 437 allows airports to charge landing fees to any aircraft operating under 14 CFR Part 121 (Air Carrier Operations), 14 CFR Part 135 (Air Charter Operations), or 14 CFR Part 91 (General Aviation Operations). Airports are not required to charge these fees, however, under the provisions of SB 437, they would be allowed that option. The fees will be charged by the airport sponsor (the owner of the airport) and will be kept by the airport to pay for infrastructure improvements.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Presently, New Mexico airports that receive funding under the Aviation Act are not permitted to charge landing fees unless the aircraft is being used in commercial operations.
