BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the crime victims reparation commission for expenditure in fiscal year 2019 to create child sexual abuse programs throughout the
