

HOUSE TAXATION AND REVENUE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL 306

53RD LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2018

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
SEVERANCE TAX BONDS; AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM CERTAIN
FUNDS AND BALANCES; REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES; CLARIFYING
CONDITIONS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS; ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS
FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF SEVERANCE TAX BOND PROCEEDS;
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OF UNEXPENDED
BALANCES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--AUTHORIZATIONS--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--**

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax
Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
authorized for purposes specified in this act. The state board

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1 of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in
2 the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a
3 finding by the board that the project has been developed
4 sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can
5 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board
6 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary
7 to comply with the federal Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
8 amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated
9 for the purposes specified in this act.

10 B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to
11 the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of
12 the severance tax bonds appropriated in this section is needed
13 for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this
14 act. If an agency has not certified the need for severance tax
15 bond proceeds for a particular project by the end of fiscal
16 year 2020, the authorization for that project is void.

17 C. Before an agency may certify for the need of
18 severance tax bond proceeds, the project must be developed
19 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

- 20 (1) incur within six months after the
21 applicable bond proceeds are available for the project a
22 substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at
23 least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and
24 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the
25 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bond

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1 proceeds are available for the project.

2 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
3 law:

4 (1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
5 of severance tax bonds appropriated in this act for a project
6 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later than
7 the following dates:

8 (a) for a project for which severance
9 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to match federal grants,
10 six months after completion of the project;

11 (b) for a project for which severance
12 tax bond proceeds were appropriated to purchase vehicles,
13 including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require
14 special equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational
15 technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not related
16 to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the
17 end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in
18 which the severance tax bond proceeds were made available for
19 the purchase; and

20 (c) for any other project for which
21 severance tax bonds were appropriated, within six months of
22 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal
23 year 2022; and

24 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
25 of severance tax bonds appropriated for a project in this act

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1 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund three months
2 after the latest reversion date specified for that type of
3 project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

4 E. Except for appropriations to the capital program
5 fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant
6 to this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

7 F. Except for a project that was originally funded
8 using a tax-exempt loan or bond issue, a project involving
9 repayment of debt previously incurred shall be funded through
10 the issuance of taxable severance tax bonds with a term that
11 does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which they are
12 issued.

13 G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
14 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
15 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
16 written obligations to third parties.

17 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
18 LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

19 A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
20 law:

21 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
22 made in this act from the general fund or other state funds
23 shall revert no later than the following dates:

24 (a) for a project for which an
25 appropriation was made to match federal grants, six months

1 after completion of the project;

2 (b) for a project for which an
3 appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including
4 emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special
5 equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or
6 other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more
7 inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the
8 fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the
9 appropriation was made for the purchase; and

10 (c) for any other project for which an
11 appropriation was made, within six months of completion of the
12 project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2020; and

13 (2) all remaining balances from an
14 appropriation made in this act for a project shall revert three
15 months after the latest reversion date specified for that type
16 of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

17 B. Except for appropriations to the capital program
18 fund, money from appropriations made in this act shall not be
19 used to pay indirect project costs.

20 C. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
21 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
22 fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
23 of this section to the capital projects fund.

24 D. Except as provided in Subsection E of this
25 section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state

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1 funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A
2 of this section to the originating fund.

3 E. The balance of an appropriation made from the
4 general fund or other state funds to the Indian affairs
5 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
6 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
7 shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of
8 this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

9 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
10 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
11 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
12 written obligations to third parties.

13 SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS PROJECT--
14 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
15 of this act, upon certification by the administrative office of
16 the courts that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
17 one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) is
18 appropriated to the administrative office of the courts to
19 purchase and install security systems and for technology
20 upgrades related to security systems at magistrate courts and
21 judicial district courts statewide.

22 SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT
23 ATTORNEYS PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the
24 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the
25 administrative office of the district attorneys that the need

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1 exists for the issuance of the bonds, one hundred twenty-five
2 thousand dollars (\$125,000) is appropriated to the
3 administrative office of the district attorneys to purchase and
4 install information technology and related system upgrades,
5 including equipment, furniture, infrastructure, storage,
6 security appliances and security monitoring devices, for
7 district attorney offices statewide.

8 SECTION 5. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT

9 PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of
10 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the aging and
11 long-term services department that the need exists for the
12 issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated
13 to the aging and long-term services department for the
14 following purposes:

- 15 1. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
16 purchase, equip and install an emergency generator at the
17 senior center in Eagle Nest in Colfax county;
- 18 2. seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) to plan,
19 design, construct, equip and furnish improvements, including
20 accessible sidewalks, a parking lot, lighting, a covered entry
21 and landscaping, for the senior center in Fort Sumner in De
22 Baca county;
- 23 3. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
24 design, construct, purchase, equip and replace the heating,
25 ventilation and air conditioning system and to purchase and

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1 install kitchen equipment at La Loma senior center in Guadalupe
2 county;

3 4. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to
4 design, construct, purchase, equip and replace the heating,
5 ventilation and air conditioning system and to purchase and
6 install kitchen equipment in the Puerto de Luna senior center
7 in Santa Rosa in Guadalupe county;

8 5. eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to plan,
9 design and construct improvements and to purchase equipment for
10 the Roy senior center in Roy in Harding county;

11 6. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan,
12 design, purchase, construct and equip a building, including
13 substructure, heating, ventilation and air conditioning,
14 plumbing, electrical system, kitchen equipment and furniture,
15 for a senior center in Hondo in Lincoln county;

16 7. sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to acquire
17 land and to plan, design, purchase and construct a facility for
18 a regional senior center in Gallup in McKinley county;

19 8. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design
20 and construct improvements, including accessibility
21 improvements, parking lot improvements, roofing and wastewater
22 connections, to the Ramah senior center in McKinley county;

23 9. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan,
24 design and construct improvements, including roofing, parking
25 lot and accessibility features, to the senior center in Thoreau

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1 in McKinley county;

2 10. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
3 design and construct a senior center in Wagon Mound in Mora
4 county;

5 11. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan,
6 design, construct, equip and renovate a senior center,
7 including parking lot improvements, in Mescalero in Otero
8 county;

9 12. fifty-nine thousand dollars (\$59,000) to
10 purchase and install kitchen and meals equipment, including a
11 commercial stove, a commercial kettle, a commercial mixer and a
12 commercial dishwasher, in the Las Vegas senior center in Las
13 Vegas in San Miguel county;

14 13. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to purchase
15 and equip home meal delivery vehicles for Torrance county;

16 14. eighteen thousand four hundred dollars
17 (\$18,400) to purchase, equip and install a replacement walk-in
18 refrigerator/freezer at the Clayton senior citizens center in
19 Clayton in Union county;

20 15. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
21 design, construct and equip renovations and to improve code
22 compliance at the Belen senior center in Belen in Valencia
23 county;

24 16. ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) to plan,
25 design, purchase and install kitchen and meals equipment at the

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1 Belen senior center in Belen in Valencia county;

2 17. sixteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$16,500)
3 to purchase and install information technology, including
4 related furniture, equipment and infrastructure, in the
5 Meadowlake senior center in Valencia county; and

6 18. twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) to plan,
7 design, purchase, construct and install a heating, ventilation
8 and air conditioning system, including furnishings and
9 equipment, in the Del Rio senior center in Rio Communities in
10 Valencia county.

11 SECTION 6. BERNALILLO COUNTY METROPOLITAN COURT PROJECT--
12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
13 of this act, upon certification by the Bernalillo county
14 metropolitan court that the need exists for the issuance of the
15 bonds, one million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated to the
16 Bernalillo county metropolitan court to plan, design,
17 construct, furnish and equip courtrooms, judges' chambers, jury
18 rooms and public and restricted access areas on the fourth
19 floor of the Bernalillo county metropolitan court courthouse in
20 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

21 SECTION 7. BORDER AUTHORITY PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX
22 BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,
23 upon certification by the border authority that the need exists
24 for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred thousand dollars
25 (\$500,000) is appropriated to the border authority to plan,

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1 design and construct a flood control structure, including land
2 acquisition and environmental assessments, at the Columbus port
3 of entry in Columbus in Luna county.

4 **SECTION 8. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECTS--SEVERANCE TAX**
5 **BONDS.**--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act,
6 upon certification by the capital program fund that the need
7 exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
8 appropriated to the capital program fund for the following
9 purposes:

10 1. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
11 plan, design, construct, furnish and equip renovations to the
12 client cottages, including client hygiene areas and staff
13 stations, at the youth diagnostic and development center in
14 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

15 2. one million five hundred thousand dollars
16 (\$1,500,000) to purchase and install equipment and to plan,
17 design, construct, renovate and furnish facilities and for
18 infrastructure improvements, including roofs, heating,
19 ventilation and air conditioning systems, lighting and interior
20 service windows, at the Albert Amador building in Espanola in
21 Rio Arriba county, the Harriet Sammons building in Farmington
22 in San Juan county and the James Murray building in Hobbs in
23 Lea county;

24 3. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to
25 plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip commission

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1 for the blind facilities in Bernalillo and Otero counties to
2 comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990;

3 4. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to purchase and
4 install equipment and infrastructure improvements, including
5 security system upgrades and servers, and to plan, design,
6 construct, renovate, furnish and equip facilities at the youth
7 diagnostic and development center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
8 county, the Camino Nuevo youth center in Albuquerque in
9 Bernalillo county and the John Paul Taylor center in Las Cruces
10 in Dona Ana county;

11 5. five million one hundred thousand dollars
12 (\$5,100,000) to plan, design, construct, equip, renovate,
13 upgrade and furnish a facility or to expand an existing state-
14 owned site to house the department of health vital records and
15 health statistics bureau in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

16 6. two hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$270,000)
17 to plan, design, construct, replace, purchase and install
18 improvements, including exterior sliding doors and fencing, at
19 the New Mexico state veterans' home in Truth or Consequences in
20 Sierra county;

21 7. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to
22 plan, design, repair and upgrade the heating, ventilation and
23 air conditioning system at the New Mexico state veterans' home
24 in Truth or Consequences in Sierra county;

25 8. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to replace,

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1 repair, renovate, purchase and install emergency generators at
2 correctional facilities statewide;

3 9. four million six hundred forty-five thousand
4 dollars (\$4,645,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
5 furnish, equip, repair, purchase and install equipment and
6 improve infrastructure, including roofs, replacement of
7 heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems and fire
8 suppression, sewer and security systems upgrades, at
9 correctional facilities statewide;

10 10. one million five hundred thousand dollars
11 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish,
12 equip, purchase and install equipment and for facility upgrades
13 at department of health facilities statewide;

14 11. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan,
15 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip state police
16 district offices, including roadway and parking lot
17 improvements, erosion control and the repair or
18 replacement of heating, ventilation and air conditioning
19 systems and surveillance systems, at district offices
20 statewide;

21 12. one million five hundred thousand dollars
22 (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, improve, renovate,
23 remediate, furnish and equip facilities, including
24 infrastructure upgrades, at state-owned facilities statewide;
25 and

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1 13. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
2 plan, design, construct, renovate and furnish and to purchase
3 and install equipment, including making other improvements to
4 address building code compliance issues, at offices of the
5 workforce solutions department statewide.

6 **SECTION 9. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--**

7 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
8 of this act, upon certification by the cultural affairs
9 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
10 the following amounts are appropriated to the cultural affairs
11 department for the following purposes:

12 1. two hundred eleven thousand three hundred
13 dollars (\$211,300) to plan, design, construct, equip, renovate
14 and improve the facilities, exhibits and site, including
15 purchase and installation of furniture and equipment, at the
16 New Mexico museum of natural history and science in Albuquerque
17 in Bernalillo county;

18 2. two hundred fifty-nine thousand five hundred
19 dollars (\$259,500) to purchase a robotic dinosaur and to plan,
20 design, construct and install an exhibit at the New Mexico
21 museum of natural history and science in Albuquerque in
22 Bernalillo county;

23 3. four hundred fifty-five thousand dollars
24 (\$455,000) to plan, design, repair and replace heating,
25 ventilation and air conditioning systems at the national

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1 Hispanic cultural center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

2 4. five hundred thirty-five thousand ninety-nine
3 dollars (\$535,099) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
4 repair, furnish, equip and make other improvements to the site,
5 facilities, theaters and exhibits, including the welcome
6 center, art museum and annex warehouse, at the national
7 Hispanic cultural center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

8 5. one hundred forty-five thousand dollars
9 (\$145,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip
10 and improve the Fort Selden historic site, including historic
11 ruins preservation, in Dona Ana county;

12 6. fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan,
13 design, construct, renovate, repair, furnish, equip and make
14 other improvements to the site, facilities and exhibits at the
15 Taylor-Barela-Reynolds-Mesilla historic site in Dona Ana
16 county;

17 7. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to plan,
18 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and improve the
19 nurses quarters building, including improvements to the site,
20 facilities and exhibits, at Fort Stanton historic site in
21 Lincoln county;

22 8. seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to
23 plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and make
24 other improvements to facilities and exhibits, including phase
25 2 of heating, ventilation and air conditioning system

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1 replacement, at the New Mexico museum of space history in
2 Alamogordo in Otero county;

3 9. thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to plan,
4 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and improve the
5 site, facilities and exhibits, including historic ruins
6 preservation, at the Coronado historic site in Sandoval county;

7 10. fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to plan,
8 design, construct, renovate, furnish, equip and improve the
9 site, facilities and exhibits, including historic ruins
10 preservation, at the Jemez historic site in Sandoval county;

11 11. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
12 plan, design and construct improvements, including
13 accessibility improvements, at the center for contemporary arts
14 in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

15 12. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to
16 plan, design, construct and equip renovations and repairs to an
17 amphitheater, including shade structures, walkways, bancos,
18 ramadas, horno ovens and a gate, at the museum of Indian arts
19 and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

20 13. two hundred three thousand three hundred
21 dollars (\$203,300) to plan, design and construct renovations
22 and other improvements to the New Mexico museum of art in Santa
23 Fe in Santa Fe county;

24 14. three hundred sixty-four thousand five hundred
25 forty-nine dollars (\$364,549) to plan, design, construct,

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1 repair, renovate and make upgrades to the palace of the
2 governors facility and site in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

3 15. fifty-six thousand dollars (\$56,000) to
4 construct and make improvements to the roof, parapets and
5 stucco at the Santa Fe children's museum in Santa Fe in Santa
6 Fe county; and

7 16. three million seven hundred thousand dollars
8 (\$3,700,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and
9 equip infrastructure for sites, facilities and exhibits,
10 including fire suppression, security systems, climate control
11 and site preservation, at museums, monuments, historic sites
12 and cultural facilities statewide.

13 **SECTION 10. CUMBRES AND TOLTEC SCENIC RAILROAD COMMISSION**
14 **PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**Pursuant to the provisions of
15 Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the Cumbres and
16 Toltec scenic railroad commission that the need exists for the
17 issuance of the bonds, seven hundred fifty thousand dollars
18 (\$750,000) is appropriated to the Cumbres and Toltec scenic
19 railroad commission for track rehabilitation and related
20 infrastructure improvements, including locomotive and boiler
21 upgrades to comply with federal railroad administration
22 standards, and for improvements to passenger cars for the
23 Cumbres and Toltec scenic railroad operating between New Mexico
24 and Colorado.

25 **SECTION 11. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE SECOND JUDICIAL**

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1 DISTRICT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the
2 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the
3 district attorney of the second judicial district that the need
4 exists for the issuance of the bonds, six hundred thousand
5 dollars (\$600,000) is appropriated to the district attorney of
6 the second judicial district to purchase and install security
7 cameras, equipment and related technology for the office of the
8 second judicial district attorney in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
9 county.

10 SECTION 12. DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE FIFTH JUDICIAL
11 DISTRICT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the
12 provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the
13 district attorney of the fifth judicial district that the need
14 exists for the issuance of the bonds, twenty-five thousand
15 dollars (\$25,000) is appropriated to the district attorney of
16 the fifth judicial district to furnish the offices of the fifth
17 judicial district attorney in the county judicial complex in
18 Lovington in Lea county.

19 SECTION 13. FIRST JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECTS--
20 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
21 of this act, upon certification by the first judicial district
22 court that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the
23 following amounts are appropriated to the first judicial
24 district court for the following purposes:

- 25 1. fifty-seven thousand five hundred dollars

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1 (\$57,500) to purchase and equip a vehicle and to purchase a
 2 speaker system for the jury room for the first judicial
 3 district court in Santa Fe county; and

4 2. sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to construct a
 5 security wall for the jury room and to purchase and install
 6 security cameras at the Steve Herrera judicial complex in the
 7 first judicial district in Santa Fe county.

8 SECTION 14. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROJECT--
 9 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
 10 of this act, upon certification by the second judicial district
 11 court that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two
 12 hundred seventy-two thousand three hundred dollars (\$272,300)
 13 is appropriated to the second judicial district court to
 14 purchase and install high-density file storage units and to
 15 purchase related equipment for the second judicial district
 16 court in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

17 SECTION 15. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROJECT--
 18 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
 19 of this act, upon certification by the economic development
 20 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
 21 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated to the
 22 economic development department to plan, design and construct
 23 infrastructure improvements in mainstreet districts statewide.

24 SECTION 16. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--
 25 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1

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1 of this act, upon certification by the public education
2 department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds,
3 the following amounts are appropriated to the public education
4 department for the following purposes:

5 1. sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) to plan,
6 design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish buildings and
7 grounds, including purchase and installation of playground and
8 other equipment, information technology, infrastructure and
9 fixtures, at ACE Leadership high school in Albuquerque in
10 Bernalillo county;

11 2. one hundred fifteen thousand nine hundred fifty
12 dollars (\$115,950) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
13 furnish and equip buildings and grounds, including the purchase
14 and installation of science and robotics equipment, playground

12 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

13 17. thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to purchase
14 and install equipment for the women's cross country team at the
15 university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

16 18. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan,
17 design and construct improvements to the women's softball field
18 at the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
19 county; and

20 19. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to
21 plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and furnish a
22 facility, including information technology and related
23 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for the northern New
24 Mexico land grant and acequia archives at the Taos branch
25 campus of the university of New Mexico in Taos county.

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1 **SECTION 39. WESTERN NEW MEXICO UNIVERSITY PROJECT--**
2 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1
3 of this act, upon certification by the board of regents of
4 western New Mexico university that the need exists for the
5 issuance of the bonds, one hundred forty-six thousand eight
6 hundred dollars (\$146,800) is appropriated to the board of
7 regents of western New Mexico university to plan, design,
8 purchase, equip and install virtual desktop infrastructure,
9 including related equipment, for remote access to campus
10 laboratory applications at western New Mexico university in
11 Silver City in Grant county.

12 **SECTION 40. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--**
13 Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from
14 the general fund to the capital program fund for expenditure in
15 fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in
16 Section 2 of this act, to develop a master plan for
17 correctional facilities statewide.

18 **SECTION 41. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--**
19 Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from
20 the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in
21 fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in
22 Section 2 of this act, to purchase and install scientific,
23 analytical and medical equipment, including the recalibration
24 of existing equipment, at department of health facilities
25 statewide.

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1 **SECTION 42. TAXATION AND REVENUE DEPARTMENT PROJECT--**
2 GENERAL FUND.--Three hundred seventy-two thousand dollars
3 (\$372,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
4 taxation and revenue department for expenditure in fiscal years
5 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
6 this act, to purchase, install and equip scanners and mail
7 slicers, including servers, information technology and related
8 equipment and infrastructure, for the revenue processing
9 division in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

10 **SECTION 43. OFFICE OF THE STATE ENGINEER PROJECTS--**
11 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND.--Notwithstanding
12 the provisions of the Water Project Finance Act to the
13 contrary, the following amounts are appropriated from the water
14 project fund to the office of the state engineer for
15 expenditure in fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise
16 provided in Section 2 of this act, for the following purposes:

17 1. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan,
18 design, construct, rehabilitate and make phase 2 improvements
19 at Morphy lake dam in Mora county and for improvements to
20 publicly owned dams statewide; and

21 2. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
22 purchase and install surface and ground water meters to assess
23 water use, water supply and impairment and to ensure public
24 welfare, conservation and water accountability statewide.

25 **SECTION 44. DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT PROJECT--**

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1 APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND.--Notwithstanding the
2 provisions of the Water Project Finance Act to the contrary,
3 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from
4 the water project fund to the department of environment for
5 expenditure in fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise
6 provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan, design and
7 construct projects to improve surface water quality and river
8 habitat statewide.

9 SECTION 45. INDIAN WATER RIGHTS SETTLEMENT FUND--

10 APPROPRIATION FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND.--Notwithstanding the
11 provisions of the Water Project Finance Act to the contrary,
12 two million eight hundred twenty-five thousand dollars
13 (\$2,825,000) is appropriated from the water project fund to the
14 Indian water rights settlement fund. Notwithstanding the
15 requirement for a joint resolution of the legislature in
16 Subsection A of Section 72-1-11 NMSA 1978, if a corresponding
17 commitment has been made for the federal portion of the
18 settlement in the Aamodt case, the money may be expended by the
19 interstate stream commission in fiscal year 2019 and subsequent
20 fiscal years to implement the state's portion of the
21 settlement, and any unexpended or unencumbered balance
22 remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert.

23 SECTION 46. PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES AUTHORITY PROJECT--

24 APPROPRIATION FROM THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--Six
25 million dollars (\$6,000,000) is appropriated from the public

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1 school capital outlay fund to the public school facilities
2 authority for expenditure in fiscal years 2018 through 2022,
3 unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan,
4 design and install school security systems and for repairs,
5 renovations or replacement of school security systems
6 statewide, contingent on the approval of the public school
7 capital outlay council.

8 SECTION 47. STATE LAND OFFICE PROJECTS--APPROPRIATIONS
9 FROM THE STATE LANDS MAINTENANCE FUND.--The following amounts
10 are appropriated from the state lands maintenance fund to the
11 state land office for expenditure in fiscal years 2018 through
12 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for
13 the following purposes:

14 1. one hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$180,000)
15 to plan, design, upgrade, repair and replace the heating,
16 ventilation and air conditioning system at the state land
17 office in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

18 2. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan,
19 design, upgrade, repair and replace the parking lot and
20 sidewalks at the state land office in Santa Fe in Santa Fe
21 county.

22 SECTION 48. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--
23 APPROPRIATION FORM THE SIKES ACCOUNT OF THE GAME PROTECTION
24 FUND.--One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from
25 the Sikes Act account of the game protection fund to the

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1 department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
2 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
3 this act, for fisheries renovation and wildlife and riparian
4 habitat restoration and for improvements at properties owned by
5 the state game commission statewide, contingent on the
6 department of game and fish not accepting the transfer of any
7 property or assets of Mesilla valley bosque state park from the
8 state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural
9 resources department in fiscal year 2018 or 2019 without prior
10 authorization from the legislature.

11 **SECTION 49. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECTS--**
12 **APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE HABITAT MANAGEMENT FUND.--**The following
13 amounts are appropriated from the habitat management fund to
14 the department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
15 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
16 this act, for the following purposes:

17 1. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design
18 and construct improvements related to safety compliance at dams
19 owned by the state game commission and at publicly owned lakes
20 and associated dams and spillways statewide; and

21 2. two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for fisheries
22 renovation and wildlife and riparian habitat restoration and
23 for improvements at properties owned by the state game
24 commission statewide, contingent on the department of game and
25 fish not accepting the transfer of any property or assets of

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1 Mesilla valley bosque state park from the state parks division
2 of the energy, minerals and natural resources department in
3 fiscal year 2018 or 2019 without prior authorization from the
4 legislature.

5 SECTION 50. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECTS--
6 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GAME PROTECTION FUND.--The following
7 amounts are appropriated from the game protection fund to the
8 department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
9 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
10 this act, for the following purposes:

11 1. three million dollars (\$3,000,000) to renovate
12 and make improvements at hatcheries owned by the state game
13 commission statewide;

14 2. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design
15 and construct improvements related to safety compliance at dams
16 owned by the state game commission and at publicly owned lakes
17 and associated dams and spillways statewide;

18 3. one million two hundred thousand dollars
19 (\$1,200,000) for fisheries renovation and wildlife and riparian
20 habitat restoration and for improvements at properties owned by
21 the state game commission statewide, contingent on the
22 department of game and fish not accepting the transfer of any
23 property or assets of Mesilla valley bosque state park from the
24 state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural
25 resources department in fiscal year 2018 or 2019 without prior

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1 authorization from the legislature; and

2 4. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to
3 plan, design, construct and improve new and existing shooting
4 ranges statewide.

5 SECTION 51. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--
6 APPROPRIATION FROM THE GAME AND FISH BOND RETIREMENT FUND.--One
7 million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the game and
8 fish bond retirement fund to the department of game and fish
9 for expenditure in fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless
10 otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to renovate and
11 make improvements at hatcheries owned by the state game
12 commission statewide.

13 SECTION 52. PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSION PROJECT--
14 APPROPRIATION FROM THE FIRE PROTECTION FUND.--Notwithstanding
15 the provisions of the Fire Protection Fund Law to the contrary,
16 two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) is
17 appropriated from the fire protection fund to the public
18 regulation commission for expenditure in fiscal years 2018
19 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this
20 act, to plan, design and construct a firefighter training burn
21 building at the firefighter training academy in Socorro in
22 Socorro county.

23 SECTION 53. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECT--APPROPRIATION
24 FROM THE CAPITOL BUILDINGS REPAIR FUND.--Four hundred fifty
25 thousand dollars (\$450,000) is appropriated from the capitol

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1 buildings repair fund to the capital program fund for
2 expenditure by the facilities management division of the
3 general services department in fiscal years 2018 through 2022,
4 unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan,
5 design, construct, renovate and improve the John F. Simms
6 building in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

7 **SECTION 54. CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND PROJECT--APPROPRIATION**
8 **FROM THE CAPITOL BUILDINGS REPAIR FUND.--**Seven hundred seventy
9 thousand dollars (\$770,000) is appropriated from the capitol
10 buildings repair fund to the capital program fund for
11 expenditure by the facilities management division of the
12 general services department in fiscal years 2018 through 2022,
13 unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, to plan,
14 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip a new state
15 police district office in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county.

16 **SECTION 55. SUPREME COURT BUILDING COMMISSION PROJECT--**
17 **APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITOL BUILDINGS REPAIR FUND.--**
18 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 15-3B-17 NMSA 1978 to
19 the contrary, one hundred twenty-three thousand dollars
20 (\$123,000) is appropriated from the capitol buildings repair
21 fund to the supreme court building commission for expenditure
22 in fiscal years 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in
23 Section 2 of this act, to plan, design, construct and renovate
24 facilities, including abatement and remediation of the exterior
25 courtyard stucco, at the supreme court building in Santa Fe in

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1 Santa Fe county.

2 SECTION 56. DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH PROJECT--
3 APPROPRIATION FROM THE BIG GAME ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT OF THE GAME
4 PROTECTION FUND.--One million seven hundred fifty thousand
5 dollars (\$1,750,000) is appropriated from the big game
6 enhancement account of the game protection fund to the
7 department of game and fish for expenditure in fiscal years
8 2018 through 2022, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of
9 this act, for fisheries renovation and wildlife and riparian
10 habitat restoration and for improvements at properties owned by
11 the state game commission statewide, contingent on the
12 department of game and fish not accepting the transfer of any
13 property or assets of Mesilla valley bosque state park from the
14 state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural
15 resources department in fiscal year 2018 or 2019 without prior
16 authorization from the legislature.

17 SECTION 57. ENVIRONMENTAL MITIGATION TRUST--CONTINGENT
18 AUTHORIZATION--BUDGET INCREASE REQUEST FOR SCHOOL BUSES.--If,
19 pursuant to the environmental mitigation trust agreement for
20 state beneficiaries entered into pursuant to the partial
21 consent decrees entered in In re: Volkswagen "Clean Diesel"
22 Marketing, Sales Practices, and Products Liability Litigation,
23 MDL No. 2672 CRB (JSC) (Dkt. No. 2103-1), the trustee approves
24 the expenditure of funds to allow the public education
25 department to replace school-district-owned buses statewide

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1 that are used to transport students to and from school pursuant
2 to the Public School Finance Act, the public education
3 department is authorized to request budget increases for that
4 purpose totaling eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) in fiscal
5 years 2019 through 2022, if that amount is approved by the
6 trustee, or any other amount that is authorized by the trustee
7 for the same purpose.

8 SECTION 58. PROJECT SCOPE--EXPENDITURES.--If an
9 appropriation for a project authorized in this act is not
10 sufficient to complete all the purposes specified, the
11 appropriation may be expended for any portion of the purposes
12 specified in the appropriation. Expenditures shall not be made
13 for purposes other than those specified in the appropriation.

14 SECTION 59. ART IN PUBLIC PLACES.--Pursuant to Section
15 13-4A-4 NMSA 1978 and where applicable, the appropriations
16 authorized in this act include one percent for the art in
17 public places fund.

18 SECTION 60. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
19 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
