2. On page 12, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following new section:

"SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2019 to administer fingerprint-based background checks for employees of school districts, charter schools and regional education cooperatives who were employed by and who have been continuously employed in a school district, charter school or regional education cooperative since 1997. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2019 shall revert to the general fund.".,
