

SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL 245

53RD LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2018

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,
EXTENDING CERTIFICATION PERIODS, EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS,
CHANGING AGENCIES AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION
OR TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY
THE LEGISLATURE IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--
20 REVERSIONS.--

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2 **SECTION 3. PASEO DEL VOLCAN LOOP BYPASS--EXTEND TIME--**
3 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
4 department of transportation project in Subsection 57 of
5 Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to acquire rights of way
6 for and to plan, design and construct paseo del Volcan loop
7 bypass road from Unser boulevard to interstate 40 in Bernalillo
8 and Sandoval counties is extended through fiscal year 2020.

9 **SECTION 4. ATRISCO LITTLE LEAGUE PARK IMPROVEMENTS--**
10 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
11 the local government division project in Subsection 2 of
12 Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design,
13 construct and equip improvements to parking areas, lighting,
14 fields, batting cages and landscaping at the Atrisco little
15 league park in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
16 year 2020.

17 **SECTION 5. BERNALILLO COUNTY CARLITO SPRINGS**
18 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
19 expenditure for the local government division project in
20 Subsection 5 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan,
21 design, construct, equip and furnish phase 2 improvements at
22 Carlito Springs in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
23 year 2020.

24 **SECTION 6. BERNALILLO COUNTY CARLITO SPRINGS OPEN SPACE**
25 WATER AND WASTEWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--

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1 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
2 department of environment project in Subsection 2 of Section 16
3 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design, construct, equip
4 and furnish water and wastewater system improvements at the
5 Carlito Springs open space in Bernalillo county is extended
6 through fiscal year 2020.

7 SECTION 7. BERNALILLO COUNTY SOUTH VALLEY GYMNASIUM AND
8 YOUTH BOXING FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
9 time of expenditure for the local government division project
10 in Subsection 15 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (S.S.)
11 to purchase property for and to plan, design, construct, equip
12 and furnish a gymnasium and youth boxing facility in the South
13 Valley in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year
14 2020.

15 SECTION 8. BERNALILLO COUNTY SOUTH VALLEY QUIET RAILROAD
16 CROSSINGS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
17 expenditure for the department of transportation project in
18 Subsection 59 of Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan,
19 design, construct and equip quiet railroad crossings in the
20 south valley of Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
21 year 2020.

22 SECTION 9. BERNALILLO COUNTY TRANSITIONAL YOUTH HOME
23 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
24 expenditure for the local government division project
25 originally authorized in Subsection 16 of Section 22 of Chapter
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1 66 of Laws 2014 and reauthorized in Laws 2016, Chapter 83,
2 Section 6 to purchase vehicles and equipment and to plan,
3 design, construct and equip improvements to a house to be used
4 as a transitional home for lesbian and gay homeless youth in
5 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

6 SECTION 10. PARADISE HILLS COMMUNITY CENTER

7 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
8 expenditure for the local government division project in
9 Subsection 11 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan,
10 design and construct improvements, additions and landscaping at
11 the Paradise Hills community center and annex and adjacent
12 parks and recreation facilities in Bernalillo county is
13 extended through fiscal year 2020.

14 SECTION 11. ROUTE 66 VISITORS CENTER ON WEST CENTRAL

15 AVENUE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
16 expenditure for the local government division project in
17 Subsection 17 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to
18 purchase, plan, construct, furnish and equip a Route 66
19 visitors center on west Central avenue in Bernalillo county is
20 extended through fiscal year 2020.

21 SECTION 12. SOUTH VALLEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CENTER

22 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
23 expenditure for the local government division project in
24 Subsection 18 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan,
25 design, construct, equip and furnish improvements and additions

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1 to the South Valley economic development center in Bernalillo
2 county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

3 SECTION 13. SUNSET ROAD IMPROVEMENTS BERNALILLO COUNTY--
4 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
5 the department of transportation project in Subsection 3 of
6 Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design and
7 construct improvements to Sunset road from the post office
8 south of Bridge boulevard to Gatewood avenue in Los Ranchos de
9 Atrisco community of Bernalillo county is extended through
10 fiscal year 2020.

11 SECTION 14. ALBUQUERQUE ATRISCO ADULT DAYCARE AND RESPITE
12 FACILITY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
13 expenditure for the local government division project
14 originally authorized in Subparagraph (a) of Paragraph (8) of
15 Subsection A of Section 18 of Chapter 105 of Laws 2010 and
16 reauthorized to the aging and long-term services department in
17 Laws 2014, Chapter 64, Section 9 and for which the time of
18 expenditure was extended in Laws 2016, Chapter 83, Section 9 to
19 purchase land and a building and to plan, design, renovate,
20 construct, furnish and equip an adult daycare and respite
21 facility in the Atrisco community in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
22 county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

23 SECTION 15. ALBUQUERQUE BIOPARK JAGUAR EXHIBIT--EXTEND
24 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
25 local government division project in Subsection 25 of Section

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1 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to design and construct a jaguar
2 exhibit at the biopark in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
3 extended through fiscal year 2020.

4 SECTION 16. ALBUQUERQUE COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY TRUCKS--
5 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
6 the local government division project in Subsection 46 of
7 Section 22 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to purchase and equip a
8 refrigerated truck and a box truck for a community food pantry
9 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
10 year 2020.

11 SECTION 17. ALBUQUERQUE DEAF CULTURE MULTIPURPOSE CENTER
12 RENOVATIONS, FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
13 TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the department of
14 transportation project originally authorized in Subsection 26
15 of Section 24 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 and reauthorized to
16 the commission for deaf and hard-of-hearing persons in Laws
17 2012, Chapter 63, Section 5 and reauthorized to extend the
18 expenditure period in Laws 2014, Chapter 64, Section 12 and
19 further reauthorized to the local government division in Laws
20 2016, Chapter 83, Section 19 to plan, design, improve and
21 construct renovations and to purchase furniture and equipment
22 for a deaf culture multipurpose center in Albuquerque in
23 Bernalillo county and to extend the expenditure period is
24 extended through fiscal year 2020.

25 SECTION 18. ALBUQUERQUE DISABILITIES DEVELOPMENT CENTER

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1 EQUIPMENT, VEHICLES AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY--EXTEND TIME--
 2 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local
 3 government division project in Subsection 47 of Section 22 of
 4 Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to purchase equipment and vehicles and
 5 to purchase and install information technology, including
 6 related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for a
 7 disabilities development center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
 8 county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

9 SECTION 19. ALBUQUERQUE EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER AND
 10 CHILDREN'S MUSEUM EXPANSION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
 11 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government
 12 division project in Subsection 35 of Section 22 of Chapter 66
 13 of Laws 2014 to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish
 14 phase 2b of a building expansion and to design, construct,
 15 purchase and install exhibits, furniture, equipment and
 16 outreach vehicles for the Explora science center and children's
 17 museum in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through
 18 fiscal year 2020.

19 SECTION 20. ALBUQUERQUE FOOD BANK WAREHOUSE EQUIPMENT AND
 20 INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--
 21 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The local government division project
 22 originally authorized in Subsection 23 of Section 22 of Chapter
 23 81 of Laws 2016 to purchase food bank warehouse equipment and
 24 related equipment in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and
 25 reauthorized in Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section 17 to include

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1 the design, purchase, assembly and equipping of expanded
2 freezer and cooler space, including compressors, wall and
3 ceiling panels, and planning, design and construction of
4 infrastructure improvements, including lighting, electrical,
5 roof and building modifications and a fire suppression system,
6 may include construction, purchase and installation of forklift
7 doors, entry points and protective bollards. The time of
8 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2020.

9 **SECTION 21. ALBUQUERQUE NORTH DOMINGO BACA**
10 **MULTIGENERATIONAL CENTER IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE**
11 **TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the aging and long-term
12 services department project in Subsection 2 of Section 4 of
13 Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design, renovate and improve
14 the North Domingo Baca multigenerational center in Albuquerque
15 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

16 **SECTION 22. ALBUQUERQUE PARKS SECURITY CAMERAS PURCHASE**
17 **AND INSTALLATION--CHANGE TO PURCHASE SECURITY CAMERAS--EXTEND**
18 **TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The unexpended balance of the
19 appropriation to the local government division in Subsection 34
20 of Section 22 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to purchase and
21 install security cameras for parks in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
22 county shall not be expended for the original purpose but is
23 changed to purchase security cameras for parks in Albuquerque.
24 The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2020.

25 **SECTION 23. ALBUQUERQUE SOUTH VALLEY PUBLIC LIBRARY**

1 EXTERIOR IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND
 2 RELATED EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
 3 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local government
 4 division in Subsection 17 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws
 5 2015 (S.S.) for improvements to the exterior, including
 6 replacing stucco, at the South Valley public library in
 7 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the
 8 original purpose but is changed to make landscaping
 9 improvements and to purchase and install information
 10 technology, including related equipment, furniture and
 11 infrastructure, at that library. The time of expenditure is
 12 extended through fiscal year 2020.

13 SECTION 24. ALBUQUERQUE WEST CENTRAL AVENUE
 14 IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
 15 BONDS.--The local government division project in Subsection 64
 16 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (S.S.) to plan, design,
 17 purchase, install and construct improvements to west Central
 18 avenue for a community development project in the West Central
 19 metropolitan redevelopment district in Albuquerque in
 20 Bernalillo county may include acquisition and purchase of land.
 21 The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2020.

22 SECTION 25. ALBUQUERQUE WESTGATE COMMUNITY CENTER
 23 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
 24 expenditure for seventy-four thousand two hundred fifty dollars
 25 (\$74,250) of the unexpended balance for the local government

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1 division project in Subsection 62 of Section 22 of Chapter 66
2 of Laws 2014 to plan, design, construct and equip, including
3 the purchase and installation of information technology and
4 related infrastructure for, a community center in the Westgate
5 community in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
6 through fiscal year 2020.

7 SECTION 26. ALBUQUERQUE WESTGATE LIBRARY IMPROVEMENTS--
8 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
9 the local government division project in Subsection 63 of
10 Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design,
11 construct and equip improvements, including the purchase and
12 installation of information technology and related
13 infrastructure, for the public library in the Westgate
14 community of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
15 through fiscal year 2020.

16 SECTION 27. ALBUQUERQUE WESTGATE LITTLE LEAGUE PARK
17 INFRASTRUCTURE AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
18 TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government
19 division project in Subsection 64 of Section 22 of Chapter 66
20 of Laws 2014 to plan, design and construct infrastructure and
21 safety improvements to Westgate little league park in
22 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
23 year 2020.

24 SECTION 28. ALBUQUERQUE WHEELS MUSEUM IMPROVEMENTS--
25 EXTEND CERTIFICATION PERIOD--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The period

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1 of time for the local government division to certify to the
 2 state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of
 3 severance tax bonds appropriated is needed for the local
 4 government division project in Subsection 56 of Section 22 of
 5 Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design and construct building
 6 improvements to the Wheels museum in Albuquerque in Bernalillo
 7 county is extended through fiscal year 2019.

8 **SECTION 29. ARENAL DRAIN BLUFF PARK CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND**
 9 **PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The local
 10 government division project originally authorized in Subsection
 11 1 of Section 31 of Chapter 226 of Laws 2013 and reauthorized in
 12 Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section 15 to purchase, plan, design
 13 and construct a park and outdoor facilities along the bluff
 14 area of the Arenal drain from west Central avenue to Bridge
 15 street, both within and outside the city limits of Albuquerque
 16 in Bernalillo county, may include the purchase of land and may
 17 include the Crestview bluff area of the Arenal drain. The time
 18 of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2020.

19 **SECTION 30. ATRISCO LITTLE LEAGUE PARK INFRASTRUCTURE AND**
 20 **SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The
 21 time of expenditure for the local government division project
 22 in Subsection 23 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to
 23 plan, design and construct infrastructure and safety
 24 improvements to the Atrisco little league park in Albuquerque
 25 in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

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1 **SECTION 31. BERNALILLO COUNTY FOOD DISTRIBUTION CENTER**
2 FURNISHINGS AND EQUIPMENT--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--
3 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The local government division project
4 originally authorized in Subsection 72 of Section 28 of Chapter
5 3 of Laws 2015 (S.S.) and reauthorized in Laws 2016, Chapter
6 83, Section 16 to furnish and equip a direct food distribution
7 center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may include
8 planning, designing, purchase, replacement and installation of
9 shelving for the center. The time of expenditure is extended
10 through fiscal year 2020.

11 **SECTION 32. ERNIE PYLE LIBRARY RENOVATION--EXTEND TIME--**
12 SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local
13 government division project in Subsection 34 of Section 22 of
14 Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 for renovation and improvements at the
15 Ernie Pyle library building in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
16 is extended through fiscal year 2020.

17 **SECTION 33. NATIONAL HISPANIC CULTURAL CENTER INFORMATION**
18 **AND WELCOME CENTER--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time
19 of expenditure for the cultural affairs department project in
20 Subsection 3 of Section 7 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan,
21 design, construct, equip and furnish an information and welcome
22 center at the entrance of the national Hispanic cultural center
23 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
24 year 2020.

25 **SECTION 34. TRUMBULL AVENUE AND SAN PEDRO STREETLIGHTS--**

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1 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
2 the department of transportation project in Subsection 17 of
3 Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to purchase and install
4 street lights along Trumbull avenue SE and San Pedro drive SE
5 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
6 year 2020.

7 SECTION 35. UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO STADIUM IMPROVEMENTS
8 AND SOUND SYSTEM--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time
9 of expenditure for the public education department project
10 originally authorized in Subsection 166 of Section 13 of
11 Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to purchase and install information
12 technology at Southwest secondary learning center in
13 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and reauthorized to the board
14 of regents of the university of New Mexico in Laws 2016,
15 Chapter 83, Section 27 for improvements, including a sound
16 system, at University stadium at the university of New Mexico
17 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
18 year 2019.

19 SECTION 36. ALBUQUERQUE WESTGATE COMMUNITY CENTER
20 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO ROBERT F. KENNEDY CHARTER SCHOOL
21 LEARNING LAB EQUIPMENT--CHANGE AGENCY--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE
22 TAX BONDS.--Forty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$49,500)
23 of the unexpended balance of the appropriation to the local
24 government division in Subsection 62 of Section 22 of Chapter
25 66 of Laws 2014 for a community center in the Westgate

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1 community in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be
2 expended for the original purpose but is appropriated to the
3 public education department to purchase and install equipment
4 for a virtual learning laboratory at Robert F. Kennedy charter
5 school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
6 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
7 year 2020.

8 SECTION 37. CATRON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FACILITY
9 AND COUNTY FAIR BUILDING--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
10 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the local government
11 division project in Subsection 76 of Section 22 of Chapter 66
12 of Laws 2014 to plan, design and construct an emergency
13 management facility and county fair building in Reserve in
14 Catron county is extended through fiscal year 2020.

15 SECTION 38. DEXTER WATER SUPPLY LINE IMPROVEMENTS--CHANGE
16 TO WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
17 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the department of
18 environment in Subsection 5 of Section 18 of Chapter 81 of Laws
19 2016 to plan, design, construct and improve the water supply
20 line in Dexter in Chaves county shall not be expended for the
21 original purpose but is changed to plan, design and construct
22 water system improvements, including wells, water supply lines
23 and water treatment, in Dexter.

24 SECTION 39. HAGERMAN BUILDING DEMOLITION AND DISPOSAL--
25 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for

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1 the local government division project in Subsection 79 of
2 Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 for building demolition
3 and disposal in Hagerman in Chaves county is extended through
4 fiscal year 2020.

5 SECTION 40. VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL STATE PARK--CHANGE
6 TO VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL--CHANGE AGENCY--SEVERANCE TAX
7 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
8 state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural
9 resources department in Subsection 1 of Section 16 of Chapter
10 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design, renovate and construct
