I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

BAAHAALI CHP SENIOR CTR-VEHICLES

eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to purchase and equip vehicles for the Baahaali chapter senior center in the Baahaali chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

GALLUP REGIONAL SENIOR CENTER

six million seventy-six thousand dollars (\$6,076,000) to acquire land and to plan, design, purchase and construct a facility for a regional senior center in Gallup in McKinley county

RED VALLEY CHP SENIOR CENTER ADDITION

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct an addition to the senior center in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TWO GREY HILLS CHP SENIOR CENTER ADDITION

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct an addition and improvements to the senior center, including improvements to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, at the Two Grey Hills chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

MUSEUM OF INDIAN ARTS & CULTURE AMPHITHEATER REN

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct and equip renovations and repairs to an amphitheater, including shade structures, walkways, bancos, ramadas, horno ovens and a gate, at the museum of Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

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MCKINLEY CO REGIONAL WATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to acquire land for and to plan, design and construct water system improvements for a regional water system that includes White Cliffs mutual domestic water users association, Gamerco water and sanitation district and Ya-Ta-Hey water and sanitation district in McKinley county

NWNM REGIONAL SOLID WASTE AUTH TRUCKS/TRAILER

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to purchase and equip trucks and a trailer for the northwest New Mexico regional solid waste authority in McKinley and Cibola counties

two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) to acquire easements and rights of way and to plan, design, construct and equip a chapter house and planned community, including infrastructure, housing and community and government service centers, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP LIVESTOCK TRAINING FACILITY CONSTRUCT/EQUIP

one million one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,175,000) to design, construct, purchase, install, furnish and equip the interior of the chapter's livestock training facility and natural resources department, including furniture, equipment, information technology and related infrastructure, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design, purchase, construct, equip and install a solid waste transfer station, including a trash compactor dumpster, a trash bin and an operator building, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP WELLS

two million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$2,750,000) to plan, design, drill, construct, equip and install water wells at the Ramah detention center site, Section 27, and for the Mountain View water system in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP WWATER SYSTEM CONSTRUCT

one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) to acquire land, easements and rights of way and to plan, design and construct a wastewater system, including a sewer line and lined lagoon, in the Mountain View area of the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

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MCKINLEY CO RD 19 CASAMERO LAKE TO NM HWY 509

three million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$3,900,000) to plan, design and construct road and drainage improvements to county road 19 from the southern boundary of Casamero Lake chapter to New Mexico highway 509 in the area of the Casamero Lake, Littlewater and White Horse Lake chapters in the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

BAAHAALI CHP VEHICLES

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and equip vehicles for the Baahaali chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

COYOTE CANYON CHP CEMETERY

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct a community cemetery, including water lines and power lines, in the Coyote Canyon chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

COYOTE CANYON CHP SENIOR SVCS VAN

thirty-three thousand four hundred sixty dollars (\$33,460) to purchase and equip vans for senior services and meal delivery in the Coyote Canyon chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

COYOTE CANYON CHP TRUCK & TRACTOR

eighty-one thousand one dollars (\$81,001) to purchase and equip a truck and tractor for the Coyote Canyon chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

COYOTE CANYON CHP WAREHOUSE

two hundred five thousand dollars (\$205,000) to construct a warehouse and garage in the Coyote Canyon chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

FORT DEFIANCE CHP POWERLINE/BATHROOMS

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct powerline extensions, house wiring and bathroom additions in the Fort Defiance chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

IYANBITO CHP CENTER RENOVATE & VEHICLE

two hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$260,000) to renovate facilities and purchase vehicles for the Iyanbito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

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TOHATCHI CHP HEAVY EQUIP BUILDING

four hundred twenty-one thousand four hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$421,479) to plan, design, construct, equip, purchase and install a building for heavy equipment storage in the Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TOHATCHI CHP WAREHOUSE CONSTRUCT

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a warehouse for the Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

one million seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,075,000) to plan, design and construct water line extensions in the Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

three million six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) to construct, equip and furnish a headstart facility in the Tse'ii'ahi' chapter of the Navajo Nation

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to purchase heavy equipment for the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHP OFFICE COMPLEX

four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) to plan, design, construct and renovate the chapter house facility as an office complex in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TWIN LAKES CHP WAREHOUSE BARN

one million two hundred one thousand seven hundred one dollars (\$1,201,701) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a warehouse barn in the Twin Lakes chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

WHITEHORSE LAKE CHP RD MAINT YARD IMPROVE

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct additions and improvements to the Navajo Nation division of transportation roads maintenance yard at the Whitehorse lake chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

WHITEHORSE LAKE/RINCON/SAND SPRINGS BATHROOMS

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design and construct bathroom additions in the Whitehorse Lake chapter and the Rincon Marquez and Sand Springs communities of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

ROCK SPRINGS CHP MULTIPURPOSE BLDG

four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) to plan, design and construct a multipurpose building and administrative office facility in the Rock Springs chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

BURNHAM CHP POWERLINE AND WIRING

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan, design and construct powerlines and house wiring in the Burnham chapter in the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TIIS TSOH SIKAAD CHP POWER LINE & WIRING

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan, design and construct power lines and house wiring in the Tiis Tsoh Sikaad chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

NAVAJO NATION IRRIGATION SYSTEMS PIPELINE

eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$87,500) to design and construct irrigation improvements, including purchase and installation of a pipeline, to Navajo Nation irrigation systems in San Juan county

TOOH HALTSOOI CHP BATHROOM ADDITIONS

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install bathroom additions in the Tooh Haltsooi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

TOOH HALTSOOI CHP NEW W FOOTHILLS POWER LINE

six hundred four thousand six hundred seventy dollars (\$604,670) to plan, design and construct the new west foothills power line extensions in the Tooh Haltsooi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

BECLABITO CHP CEMETERY FENCE

fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000) to plan, design and construct a fence at the community cemetery in the vicinity of the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

three hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$315,000) to plan, design and construct a helipad in the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

two million two hundred thousand dollars (\$2,200,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a government complex, including related infrastructure and a commercial kitchen, at the Gadii'ahi chapter in the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct power line extensions in the Lake Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct the yellow pointed rock water line in the Lake Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design and construct water lines and bathroom additions in the Red Valley chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

eight hundred fifty-nine thousand four hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$859,477) to construct, renovate and equip the chapter house building in the White Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

six million one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$6,170,000) to plan, design and construct a public safety, judicial and social service complex at the Pueblo of Santa Ana in Sandoval county

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to demolish and to plan, design, construct, equip and replace water storage tanks and appurtenances at the Pueblo of Santa Ana in Sandoval county

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to purchase and equip vehicles for the police department in Gallup in McKinley county

SAN JUAN CO YOUTH DETENTION CENTERS EQUIP

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to purchase and install drug and metal detection equipment in youth detention centers in San Juan county

two million five hundred two thousand dollars (\$2,502,000) to acquire rights of way and to plan, design and construct improvements to Ciniza drive in Gallup in McKinley county

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to acquire rights of way and to plan, design and construct improvements to alleys in the historic downtown in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP VETERANS' CEMETERY ACCESS ROAD

six hundred fifty-one thousand dollars (\$651,000) to plan, design and construct an access road for the veterans' cemetery in Gallup in McKinley county

three million six hundred thousand dollars (\$3,600,000) to plan, design and construct phase 1 improvements to Navajo route 5113 in the Beclabito chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design and construct a faculty housing complex for Navajo technical university in Crownpoint in McKinley county

DINÉ COLLEGE PINTO LIBRARY INFO TECH & SHADES

twenty-eight thousand six hundred fifty-seven dollars (\$28,657) to purchase and install information technology and window shades, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for the Senator John Pinto library at Diné college in Shiprock in San Juan county

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ENMU ROBOTICS CHALLENGE EQUIP

sixty-six thousand five hundred seventy-five dollars (\$66,575) to purchase educational robotics equipment for elementary through high school students and teachers for use in robotic design and related coding curricula for math and science classes, including a Native American voice-controlled autonomous robot and an innovation kit, for eastern New Mexico university programs serving school districts in Bernalillo, Cibola, Lincoln, McKinley, San Juan, Sandoval, Santa Fe, Socorro, Rio Arriba and Taos counties
