### **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

The bill amends the Public School Finance Act to change how size adjustment units are calculated in the public education funding formula. The bill prohibits any school serving fewer than three grade levels from generating size adjustment program units and aggregates the student membership of any elementary school, junior high school, or senior high school located within one mile of another school of the same type in size adjustment calculations. School districts with a student membership (MEM) of less than 500 students are exempted from the provisions of the bill. This bill is endorsed by the LFC and LESC and has an effective date of July 1, 2019.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill changes how public school funding is distributed to each school district and charter school but does not change the overall program cost appropriation. Estimated operating budget impacts will vary for each school district and charter school. In FY18, school districts and charter schools statewide will generate 21.5 thousand size adjustment program units for elementary and junior high schools with less than 200 MEM and for senior high schools with less than 400 MEM, based on FY18 final funding formula data. The total value of these size adjustment program units is \$87.2 million at the final FY18 unit value of \$4,053.55.

#### Senate Bill 147 – Page 2

Based on FY18 preliminary funding formula data, the bill eliminates 6,376 size adjustment units across 84 schools and redistributes roughly \$25.8 million back through the formula. The bill eliminates 1,081 units from 22 schools with fewer than three grade levels and 5,295 size adjustment units from 62 schools within one mile of another school of the same type.

Based on FY18 program cost and an estimated one percent increase to the FY18 unit value, the bill would increase the program cost of 62 out of 97 charter schools and 79 of 89 school districts after redistributing funds.

Attachment A shows the estimated change in program cost for each school district and charter school from this bill using FY18 final program cost and size adjustment unit data. Attachment B contains a list of schools that currently serve fewer than three grade levels. Attachment C lists schools that are located within one mile of another school of the same type.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

A 2017 LFC/LESC joint progress report noted examples of 15 schools adjacent to, or sharing a facility with, another school of the same grade level generating 627 school size adjustment units and \$2.5 million in program cost in FY18. According to Public Schools Facility Authority data, a total of 62 schools receiving size adjustment units are located within one mile of another school of the same type.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS**

The bill would require PED to change its policies and procedures for calculating school size adjustments units for school districts and charter schools. PED and public schools must comply with provisions of the bill by FY20.

#### RELATIONSHIP

This bill relates to House Bill 188 and Senate Bill 157, which adjust the at-risk index and phase-in a teacher cost index in the funding formula; SB 36, which makes an appropriation to the state equalization guarantee; and Senate Bill 196, which caps the age of students in K-12 to 21.

### **OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES**

Previous LESC and LFC studies have noted the size adjustment factor has been vulnerable to manipulation. In addition, the number of size adjustment program units has increased in recent years. For FY18, preliminary data indicates a total of twenty one thousand five hundred forty two size adjustment units based on school size, but in FY09 only eighteen thousand six hundred seven program units were generated based on school size.

Current law prohibits "separate established to provide special programs" from generating size adjustment program units. Despite this, some of the schools affected by this bill appear to offer special educational programs, often at the same facility or near an existing facility that serves students at the same grade levels.
